ORDER

On January 29, 1987, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel), Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Southwestern Bell), General Telephone Company of the Midwest, ALLTEL Missouri, Inc., United Telephone Company of Missouri, Contel System of Missouri, Inc., Fidelity Telephone Company, Missouri Telephone Company and Mid-Missouri Telephone Company (hereinafter collectively referred to as "signatories") submitted a Joint Recommendation concerning the replacement of the intraLATA toll pool in accordance with the Commission's orders of July 24, 1986, September 17, 1986, and November 14, 1986.

The Joint Recommendation contains a conceptual framework for the replacement of the intraLATA toll pool. This conceptual framework is supported by all Missouri local exchange companies, Staff and with the exception of the proposed NTS cost shifts, Public Counsel. In order to implement the proposed plan, the signatories have suggested a procedural schedule.

The signatories state that prior to committing the resources necessary to continue work on the plan, they desire an indication from the Commission that the key elements of the conceptual framework are acceptable. To that end the signatories suggest that all interested nonsignatory parties should be required to file comments regarding the conceptual framework no later than March 2, 1987, and reply comments if necessary, no later than March 9, 1987.

The Commission is of the opinion that the request of the signatories on this matter is reasonable and should be granted.

The Commission is further of the opinion that the signatories should provide the revenue requirement effects of the NTS cost shift plan set forth in the Joint Recommendation. This information should be provided in the same format as the analysis of the five, seven and ten-year shifts which appear in Exhibit B of the Joint Recommendation.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That all interested nonsignatory parties shall file comments regarding the conceptual framework on or before March 2, 1987.

ORDERED: 2. That any reply comments regarding conceptual framework shall be filed on or before March 9, 1987.

ORDERED: 3. That in addition to the parties of record to this proceeding, the Secretary of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order on all persons or entities who have acquired certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide intrastate toll telecommunications services in the State of Missouri after November 14, 1986.

ORDERED: 4. That the signatory parties shall submit the information concerning the revenue requirement effects of the NTS cost shift plan set forth in the Joint Recommendation on or before March 2, 1987.

ORDERED: 5. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
