On July 27, 1994, the Staff of the Commission filed a memorandum recommending that COS be implemented between Auxvasse and Fulton within 120 days.

Inasmuch as the petitioning route has met the calling criteria set forth by the Commission in Case No. TO-87-131, the Commission finds that a community of interest has been demonstrated. Thus, the Commission determines that COS should be implemented between the Auxvasse exchange and the Fulton exchange within 120 days of the effective date of this Order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Kingdom Telephone Company and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company shall implement community optional service between the Auxvasse exchange and the Fulton exchange on or before December 27, 1994.
2. That this Order shall become effective on August 29, 1994.
