**ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On July 1, 1994, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Docket which set a procedural schedule herein. On July 7, 1994, the Office of Public Counsel (OPC) filed its Motion For an Alternative Procedural Schedule which would allow additional time for several of the deadlines in the procedural schedule. On July 7, 1994, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), the Small Telephone Company Group (STCG), GTE Telephone Operations - Midwest (GTE), ALLTEL Missouri, Inc. (ALLTEL) and Mid-Missouri Telephone Company Group (Mid-MO) (hereafter SWBT, et al.) filed their Joint Motion to Modify the Procedural Schedule which also asked for extensions in the various deadlines. On July 8, 1994, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed a Notice in which it concurred with the Joint Motion to Modify the Procedural Schedule as filed by SWBT, et al.

On July 12, 1994, the Commission issued a Notice in which the procedural schedule was suspended and the parties were notified that no further deadlines would be observed pending a new procedural schedule to be issued by the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the motions for changes in the procedural schedule and finds that it would be appropriate to allow additional time in which the participants may disseminate comments and responses. The Commission finds that this docket does not involve an

operation of law date which would restrict extensions of deadlines and the Commission further finds that the extended schedule would provide additional time for the participants to thoroughly consider and evaluate the potential changes within the industry which are anticipated by this particular docket. The procedural schedule for this docket will therefore be revised as set out below.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**


1. That the procedural schedule is revised as set out below:

Questions concerning initial comments served on participants	August 26, 1994
Reply comments and responses to questions	September 16, 1994
First technical conference	September 30, 1994
Second technical conference	October 14, 1994
Hearings (if found necessary by the Commission)	Oct. 27 & 28, 1994

The technical conferences will be held at the Commission Headquarters in the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 W.
