# STATE OF MISSOURI PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

At a Session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 20th day of January, 1984.

## CASE NO. ER-82-52

In the matter of Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, for authority to file tariffs increasing rates for electric service provided to customers in the Missouri service area of the Company.

# CASE NO. ER-83-163

In the matter of Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, for authority to file tariffs increasing rates for electric service provided to customers in the Missouri service area of the Company.

### CASE NO. EM-83-248

In the matter of the joint application of the utility companies comprising the Union Electric System for permission and authority (i) to merge Missouri Utilities Company, Missouri Power & Light Company and Missouri Edison Company with and into Union Electric Company and (ii) to carry out the transactions contemplated by the mergers.

#### ORDER

On January 9, 1984, Union Electric Company (UE) filed its report in compliance with ordered paragraph three of the Commission's order issued herein on March 1, 1983, directing UE to file, on or before January 31, 1984, a report regarding the status of the proposed merger in Case No. EM-83-248, and the possible elimination of a previously ordered study involving assistance to subsidiaries. The Commission's order of March 1, 1983, also vacated orders issued in Case No. ER-82-52 and ER-83-163 requiring the performance of the study.

The Report of Union Electric Company filed herein on January 9, 1984, recites that this Commission entered its order in Case No. EM-83-248 authorizing the merger of the involved subsidiaries with and into Union Electric Company. The order was effective December 28, 1983, authorizing the merger effective December 30, 1983.

UE has requested the Commission to enter an order eliminating the previously ordered study by UE of the level and nature of UE's assistance to its subsidiaries because the study is no longer necessary as a result of the elimination of the corporate entities of the subsidiaries.

In the Commission's opinion the request is reasonable and proper and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the requirement of the filing, by Union Electric Company, of the Study Regarding the Reasonableness of the Level and Nature of Service to Subsidiaries be, and is, hereby vacated and no further proceedings shall be held in that regard in Cases No. ER-82-52, ER-83-163 and EM-83-248.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
