ORDER APPROVING SIXTH YEAR PHASE-IN TARIFF SHEETS

By its Order in Case No. ER-85-265 on April 24, 1986, this Commission authorized Arkansas Power & Light Company (APL) of Little Rock, Arkansas, to file tariffs designed to increase rates through a phase-in over a period of several years.

On March 11, 1988, the Commission issued an Order Approving Stipulation And Agreement And Tariff Sheets that adjusted the amount of increase for the remaining phase-in periods and disposed of all outstanding matters and appeals of Case No. ER-85-265.

On February 21, 1991, APL filed tariffs to comply with the Orders of this Commission in Case No. ER-85-265. The proposed tariffs represent an 11.59 percent decrease below the level effective March 21, 1990. On February 25, 1991, APL filed a Motion seeking approval on less than 30 days notice.

On March 18, 1991, the Staff filed its recommendation in this matter seeking approval of the filed tariffs. In the Commission's opinion the Staff's recommendation should be adopted and the tariffs should be approved. The Commission is also of the opinion that the Motion of APL should be granted and, that sufficient good cause is shown for approval on less than the customary 30 days notice since the tariffs are in compliance with the Commission's previous orders and provide a rate decrease which should be made available to the Company's customers as soon as possible.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheets submitted by Arkansas Power & Light Company for the purpose of decreasing rates for electric service provided to customers in its Missouri service area, be approved and made effective for service rendered on and after March 21, 1991.
