ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

By its Report and Order issued on June 9, 1981, to be effective on June 21, 1981, this Commission authorized a stipulation On Transit Subsidy where the Company and Staff agreed that the existing transit subsidy that flows from steam and electric rates should be eliminated. By mutual agreement of the City of St. Joseph, the Company, and the Staff, said transit subsidy should continue for a period of forty-two (42) months from the effective date of the Report and Order issued in this proceeding (June 21, 1981). Further, it was agreed that the City of St. Joseph would make a good faith effort to initiate a new transit system as quickly as possible.

It has come to the attention of the Commission that the City of St. Joseph on December 21, 1984 will be in full operation and control of the transit system operating in the City of St. Joseph.

On November 19, 1984, St. Joseph Light & Power Company filed tariffs to eliminate the transit subsidy from steam and electric rates. The Company also proposes to cancel the tariff sheets for the chartered transportation service.

The Commission is of the opinion the proposed electric and steam tariffs submitted on November 19, 1984, by St. Joseph Light & Power Company of St. Joseph, Missouri, comply with its Report and Order issued on June 9, 1981, and said tariffs should be allowed to become effective for service rendered on and after December 21, 1984. The Commission is also of the opinion the transit tariffs of the Company should be cancelled as of the effective date of this Order.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the following electric tariffs submitted on November 19, 1984, by St. Joseph Light & Power Company of St. Joseph, Missouri, for the purpose of complying with the Report and Order, pertaining to the transit subsidy, issued in this case on June 9, 1981, are hereby approved and made effective for service rendered on and after December 21, 1984.
