## ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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On May 6, 1992, Missouri Public Service, a Division of UtiliCorp United Inc. (MPS) filed its Application pursuant to 393.170, RSMo 1986 for a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide natural gas service in the state of On May 22, 1992, an Order and Notice was issued setting an intervention date of June 22, 1992, and this period has passed without any application for intervention.

On January 15, 1993, Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) submitted its Motion to Establish a Procedural Schedule in which it alleged that the applicant consented to the proposed schedule. Based upon the issue(s) raised by the Application and also based upon Staff's Motion, the Commission finds that a procedural schedule should be established in order to facilitate the hearing process. On February 22, 1993, Staff filed a Memorandum containing a revised procedural schedule and an indication that all parties have consented to the revised schedule. The Commission will grant Staff's Motion as amended, and subject to the Commission's schedule as set out below.
