ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 26, 1993, West Elm Place Corporation (WEPC) filed an Application with the Commission for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct an extension to an existing sewer system, located generally within the City of Arnold, Jefferson County, Missouri.

In order to facilitate this case in the most expeditious and least expensive manner, the Commission authorized an early prehearing conference to take place on July 23, 1993. Apparently no resolution to this matter could be reached at that time.

On December 15, 1993, a notice was issued stating that a suggested procedural schedule should be filed in this matter no later than January 15, 1994. A motion to establish a procedural schedule was filed by WEPC on December 16, 1993, to which the Staff and OPC have consented.

The applicants motion is granted and, by consent of the parties, the Commission adopts the following procedural schedule in this matter with one modification, that being the date of the evidentiary hearing:


Direct testimony of the applicant	January 14, 1994
Rebuttal testimony of the Staff, OPC and Intervenor	February 14, 1994
Surrebuttal and cross-surrebuttal testimony	February 28, 1994
Prehearing conference with evidentiary hearing to follow immediately	March 7, 1994

The prehearing conference will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission's hearing room located at the Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Room 530, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101.
