ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Applications to intervene in the above-styled matter have been filed by General Motors Corporation, Monsanto Company, PPG Industries, Inc., Union Carbide Corporation (Monsanto, et al.), Anheuser-Busch, Inc., Doe Run Company and ASARCO, Inc. On January 5, 1987, Monsanto, et al., and Anheuser-Busch, Inc., filed a request for leave to file comments on the responses that the utilities have filed no later than January 9, 1987.

The Commission having reviewed the applications to intervene filed in this proceeding and the requests for leave to file comments submitted by Monsanto et al., and Anheuser-Busch, Inc., determines that they should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the applications to intervene in this proceeding filed by General Motors Corporation, Monsanto Company, PPG Industries, Inc., Union Carbide Corporation (Monsanto, et al.), Anheuser-Busch, Inc., Doe Run Company and ASARCO, Inc., be, and they are, hereby granted.

ORDERED: 2. That Monsanto, et al., and Anheuser-Busch, Inc., be, and they are, hereby granted leave to file comments no later than January 12, 1987, on the responses filed by the utilities in this proceeding.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
