ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

By its Order issued in these cases on August 28, 1987, this Commission authorized Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to file revised tariffs reflecting credits in the form of an across-the-board percentage credit to all classes of residential local service access lines as contemplated by the Stipulation and Agreement approved therein.
