

reduced Federal tax liability under the Tax
Reform Act of 1986.

ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On December 7, 1987, The Kansas Power and Light Company (KPL Gas Service) of Topeka, Kansas, filed tariffs to decrease its sales and transportation service rate schedules to further reflect anticipated reduced federal tax liabilities due to the Tax Reform Act (TRA) of 1986. This instant filing represents an annual reduction of \$1,500,118.

Previously, this Commission approved a partial TRA reduction of \$529,064 effective March 9, 1987, for KPL Gas Service. The combined effect of the instant filing and the March 9, 1987, reduction will reflect an annual decrease of \$2,029,164 by KPL Gas Service due to the TRA.

On December 29, 1987, KPL Gas Service submitted modifications to several of the initially filed tariff sheets, as well as several additional sheets to comply with the penalty billing requirements of Section 34.055 RSMo Supp. 1987.

Based on the recommendations of its Staff, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariffs are reasonable and should be allowed to go into effect on less than 30 days notice to provide for an immediate reduction in customers' bills for service rendered on and after January 4, 1988.

Additionally, the Company's request for a finding by this Commission that it has satisfied the obligations imposed on it by AO-87-48 is reasonable and should be granted.

ORDERED: 1. That for the reasons recited herein, the following tariff sheets filed by The Kansas Power and Light Company of Topeka, Kansas, on December 7, 1987, and as modified by their filing on December 29, 1987, reflecting a decrease due to the TRA be, and they are, hereby approved and authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after January 4, 1988.
