## ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

The Commission issued a Report and Order in this case on August 26, 1994, approving the Stipulation and Agreement (Stipulation) signed and presented to the Commission by Raytown Water Company (company), Commission Staff, the City of Raytown, and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC). In that Report and Order the Commission authorized the company to file revised tariff sheets reflecting the revenue increase set out in the Stipulation of the parties as follows: "the company is authorized to file . . . revised tariff sheets designed to increase revenue by \$420,000 for service on and after September 15, 1994, in accordance with the Stipulation approved in Ordered Paragraph 1." On August 29, 1994, OPC filed its Motion For Clarification, arguing that the reference to an increase of \$420,000 was not clear and asking that the Commission clarify its order. No responses to the motion were filed within the ten-day period specified by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(9).

The Commission, having considered the Motion For Clarification, finds that the motion is not well taken and should be denied. Movant OPC was a signatory to the Stipulation approved in the Report and Order. The Report and Order echoes the language of the Stipulation and specifies that the tariff sheets

be revised in accordance with that Stipulation.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. The Motion For Clarification filed herein by the Office of the Public Counsel be denied.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
