As a homeowner in the Spokane Highlands subdivision, I would like to express my extreme displeasure over the proposed increase in our water rates.

Never in my experience have I ever encountered a seventy-six percent increase in any utility at one time; or any other field for that matter. The general public understands creeping inflation. In 1957 gasoline was nineteen cents a gallon, now it is close to \$3.00 a gallon. But that inflation took over fifty years to accomplish and was dictated by world events. I am not against a reasonable increase. We all have to live and adjust to creeping inflations; however, seventy-six percent is not only excessive but is obscene. Obviously there are other factors involved here and I certainly would not be comfortable until these factors were analyzed to justify such a hearty increase. Two and half, five, or even ten percent *may* be justifiable, but certainly not seventy-six percent in one stroke of a pen. I hope the Public Utility Commission can investigate this matter and resolve this matter in a fair and equitable conclusion for the homeowners of Spokane Highlands.

We are concerned about our possible rate increase for water within the Spokane Highlands Water Co district. We are interested to hear what the increase will be used for and how it will benefit customers. We completely understand the need for prices to go up, it seems like everything does. Our concern is the need for a 76.1% increase. This increase was not expected, nor was it budgeted.

In the past 12 months our cost for electricity (same company that provides electricity to the well) has gone up 6%. The initial customer notice we received was inadequate in explaining what the rate increase would be used for. The letter explained the rate increase was necessary due to "whatever was said in the letter". We are looking for a better explanation.

Our current system is quite adequate and is already higher in price than some other districts in the area. Other areas, within cities or villages, are paying close to our current rates for water *and* sewer – in some areas this amount includes trash as well. We have the addition expense of our septic system.

While we appreciate the convenience of having a community well, this is our only real option for water and an increase of this magnitude seems like they are taking advantage of their customers.

The current owners of Spokane Highlands Water Company took over operation of the company roughly a year and a half ago. These are very dramatic changes to be taken within the first 2 years of ownership. It seems to us that they are looking for a bigger return on their investment. What is to come next year?

We would like to be contact about this issue.

I am sending this email in response to the comments you submitted regarding the above-referenced subject. Please be advised that the rate increase request you commented upon is simply that, a request by the Company. A rate increase will not occur unless the Commission approves one, and that will not happen unless the Staff of the Commission has submitted a recommendation for approval of an increase to the Commission.

The Staff is currently auditing the Company's books and records to determine if it believes a rate increase is warranted. The Staff is also conducting reviews of the Company's miscellaneous service charges and connection fees, the Company's operation of its utility facilities, the Company's business operations and the Company's tariff provisions to see if any changes regarding those matters are warranted. When the Staff's audit and reviews are completed, the Staff will work with the Company, and the Office of the Public Counsel, in an attempt to reach an agreement regarding the Company's request.

If at least the Staff and the Company reach an agreement regarding the Company's request, proposed tariff revisions, a written agreement and a Staff recommendation for approval of the tariff revisions and the agreement will be submitted to the Commission for its consideration. Depending on whether the Public Counsel joins in the agreement, if one is reached, a notice regarding the results of the agreement may or may not be sent to the Company's customers. If an agreement regarding the Company's request is not reached between at least the Staff and the Company, no rate increase will occur.

Thank you for taking the time to submit your comments regarding the Company's request, and again please note that a rate increase will not occur unless the Commission approves one.

This letter is in response to the request #QW-2008-003 from Olivia A. Turner, President of the Spokane Highlands Water Company for an increase of 76.1% to the current water rate.

I have researched the water rates around Missouri and find that this increase would put the Spokane Highlands Water Company rates among the highest in Missouri. In fact, Spokane Highlands Water Company's current rates are already as high, or higher than most water providers in the state of Missouri. Most providers supply at least 1,000 gallons to the minimum monthly charge. However, Spokane Highlands minimum charge of \$10.00 does not. The current rate of \$3.03 per 1,000 gallons of usage appears to be average for the state of Missouri. I do not oppose a reasonable increase, but one of this magnitude, I think other residence, as well as myself, will have no other choice but to explore other options such as drilling our own wells or sharing a well with other residence.

Mr. and Mrs. Turner do not have an exclusive on the water. They provide a service, and as long as that service is dependable, as well as affordable, I believe most of the residence of Spokane Highlands Subdivision will continue to use the service they provide.

I have included water rates from around the state for your review. I anticipate that a modest increase, if warranted by the commission, be the out come of the request made by Mrs. Turner.
