ORDER RECORDING FICTITIOUS NAME AND
ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On May 24, 1994, West Coast Telecommunications, Inc. (WCT) submitted a proposal for authority to add the fictitious name "World Call Telecommunications" (World Call) to its tariff and certificate of service authority. Pursuant to communication from the Commission, WCT filed its Adoption Notice for the change of name on June 20, 1994.

On September 14, 1994, WCT filed tariff sheets to add the new Premiere line of services to its existing tariff and the new sheets reflected the name of World Call Telecommunications. This tariff filing was docketed in the change of name docket indicated above. The tariffs filed reflect an effective date of October 18, 1994.

On October 11, 1994, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of the fictitious name and also approval of the tariff. The Premiere services which were included in the tariff filing include 1+ switched services, travel card service, dedicated T-1 service, switched and dedicated 800 service and debit card service. At the request of the Telecommunications Department Staff, WCT submitted substitute pages on October 3, 1994.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filing and change of name request along with the Staff Memorandum and the entirety of the file and finds that it is in the public interest for the certificate of service authority and the tariffs to reflect the name under which the regulated utility conducts business. The Commission further finds that the services offered in the tariff filing under the Premiere services label are competitive services and that furthering the availability of these services is in the public interest. The Commission will approve the change of name and the tariff filed for service on and after October 18, 1994.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That Commission records will record the name change of West Coast Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a World Call Telecommunications.
2. That the tariffs filed herein are approved for service on and after October 18, 1994:
