SECOND ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 2, 1993, Western Resources, Inc., d/b/a Gas Service, A Western
Resources Company, (Gas Service or Company) filed a Motion To Modify Procedural
Schedule in this case. On February 23, 1993 the Commission issued its first
Order Modifying Procedural Schedule that suspended the schedule with respect to
"take-or-pay" related issues until further order and amended the filing deadline
for surrebuttal testimony on the remaining issues to March 3, 1993. Gas Service
states in this Motion that a modest extension in the procedural schedule as it
relates to the remaining issue, the Riverside issue, would also be appropriate
in that it would provide the parties an opportunity to resolve this issue without
further proceedings. The additional time is necessary for the exchange of
information to facilitate a settlement or resolution. Gas Service in its Motion
requests an extension date for the hearing memorandum, surrebuttal testimony and
hearing. Gas Service states that all parties who participated in the prehearing
conference have been advised of the Motion and have no objections to a modifica-
tion of the procedural schedule.

The Commission is of the opinion that the Motion To Modify Procedural Schedule filed herein is reasonable and should be granted as requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule established by the Commission and as amended by Notice dated January 15, 1993 and Order Modifying Procedural Schedule issued by the Commission on February 23, 1993, be hereby further amended as follows:

Hearing memorandum or
stipulation and agreement

March 25, 1993

Gas Service files surrebuttal
testimony, if necessary

April 15, 1993

Hearing, if necessary

April 29-30, 1993
10:00 a.m.

2. That the surrebuttal testimony, hearing memorandum and hearing as herein set be partially suspended with respect to "take-or-pay" related issues only, until further order of the Commission and as previously ordered.

3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
