area of the Company.

ORDER REQUESTING COMMENTS

Arkansas Power & Light Company filed proposed tariffs on June 7, 1985. These proposed tariffs include a rider which is designed to recover \$12,177,000 in additional Missouri retail revenue associated with a 36 percent allocation of Grand Gulf I nuclear plant. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued its decision in Docket No. ER-82-616-000 on June 13, 1985.

On June 20, 1985, Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L) presented to this Commission a proposed settlement in the FERC Docket No. ER-82-616-000. AP&L requests the Commission's response no later than July 15, 1985, as it believes that Grand Gulf I nuclear plant will begin commercial operation on July 1, 1985.

The Commission requests the parties to the last AP&L rate case, ER-85-20, to file recommendations on how the Commission should proceed on the proposed settlement and, if possible, comments on any and all aspects of the settlement.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the Secretary of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order upon all parties to Case No. ER-85-20, Re: Arkansas Power & Light Company, (issued May 31, 1985).

ORDERED: 2. That the parties to the last Arkansas Power & Light Company case, ER-85-20, shall file recommendations on how the Commission should proceed on the proposed settlement and, if possible, comments on any and all aspects of the settlement by 5:00 p.m. on June 27, 1985.

ORDERED: 3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
