ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND EFFECTIVE DATE OF REPORT AND ORDER

On July 2, 1984, the Commission issued its Report and Order in the above-styled cases, the same to become effective on July 12, 1984.

On July 5, 1984, the companies filed a motion to extend the effective date of the Report and Order until July 31, 1984.
