ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND EFFECTIVE DATE
OF REPORT AND ORDER

On July 2, 1984, the Commission issued its Report and Order in the above-styled cases, the same to become effective on July 12, 1984.

On July 5, 1984, the companies filed a motion to extend the effective date of the Report and Order until July 31, 1984. In support of the motion the companies assert that additional time is required in order for the companies to be able to file tariffs and otherwise comply with the Commission's Report and Order.

The Commission, having considered the companies' motion, concludes it is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the effective date of the Report and Order issued in the above-styled cases on July 2, 1984, be, and it is, hereby extended from July 12, 1984, to July 31, 1984.
