ORDER DENYING REHEARING

On October 16, 1992, the Commission issued an Order Denying Intervention with an effective date of October 27, 1992. Within the Order, the Commission denied intervenor status in this case to Osage Valley Electric Cooperative (Osage). On October 21, 1992, Osage filed an application for rehearing. Osage argued that it has an interest different from that of the general public and that its intervention in this case would serve the public interest.

Pursuant to Section 386.500, RSMo 1986, the Commission shall grant a rehearing "if in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Upon review of Osage's application, the Commission finds that there is not sufficient reason to order a rehearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the application of Osage Valley Electric Cooperative for rehearing is hereby denied.

2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
