ORDER GRANTING IN PART, AND DENYING IN PART, MOTION TO CORRECT ORDER

On December 21, 1994, Missouri Public Service (MPS or company) filed a motion requesting corrections to the Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement issued on December 19, 1994. MPS stated that the language rejecting previously filed tariff sheets was erroneous, unnecessary, and moot since the tariff sheets referred to had already been superseded by new tariff sheets for the most recent ACA period as part of Case no. GR-94-331. MPS requested an order of correction.

Having thoroughly reviewed company's motion and the order in question, the Commission is of the opinion that the language to which MPS referred is, indeed, unnecessary and that the subject tariffs have been superseded. However, the Commission also agrees with MPS that the point is moot. Therefore, no correction order is necessary. The language complained of does not operate to prevent the parties from carrying out the terms of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement; nor does it act to delay the filing of new tariff sheets required by the Commission's order. The Commission believes the company's motion should be granted to the extent that it requests acknowledgement of the inappropriateness of the language rejecting tariff sheets, and denied in that no correction order is needed

to achieve the Commission's purposes in approving the agreement of the parties.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion to Correct Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement is granted in part and denied in part as discussed above.
- 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
