At a Session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 18th day of September, 1981.

CASE NO. EO-82-65

In the matter of Kansas City Power & Light Company of Kansas City, Missouri, for authority to file a Levelized Payment Plan for residential customers in the Missouri service area of the Company.

ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION

On August 13, 1981, the Kansas City Power & Light Company of Kansas City, Missouri, submitted to this Commission a Levelized Payment Plan for residential customers in the Missouri service area of the Company. The proposed rules had a requested effective date of September 14, 1981. On September 11, 1981, the proposed tariffs were suspended for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days beyond September 14, 1981, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

The Levelized Payment Plan is offered by the Company for certain customers who wish to make equal monthly payments instead of paying their actual monthly bills and who meet certain credit recordeligibility.

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed Plan should be allowed to become effective on an interim basis in order that said Plan be evaluated for a period, beginning September 30, 1981, and ending December 15, 1982, unless otherwise ordered by this Commission.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the tariff sheets filed by Kansas City
Power & Light Company of Kansas City, Missouri, on August 13, 1981,
are hereby disallowed and that Company is ordered to file in lieu thereof
amended tariff sheets for Commission approval to comply with this Order
by September 23, 1981, to become effective September 30, 1981.

ORDERED: 2. That Company shall file with the Commission quarterly reports indicating the number of customers electing said plan, terminating said election, and any action of Company to terminate a customer's participation, as well as Company or Customers reasons therefor.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
