ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

By order issued on March 22, 2000, the Commission granted to MGC Communications, Inc. (MGC) a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in Missouri. MGC filed a basic local service tariff (Tariff No. 200001151) on June 9, with an effective date of July 24. On the same date, MGC also filed an Exchange Access Tariff (Tariff No. 200001152) with an effective date of July 24. MGC subsequently extended the effective date of both tariffs to August 7. MGC filed substitute tariff sheets for Tariff No. 200001151 on July 14 and July 25. MGC filed substitute tariff sheets for Tariff No. 200001152 on July 13, July 18, and July 25. The Commission's Staff reviewed the tariff sheets and filed a Staff Recommendation and Memorandum on July 27, recommending that the Commission approve them as amended by the substitute sheets.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets, as amended, conform to the Commission's Order of March 22, and should be approved to become



effective on August 7, 2000. The certificate of service authority granted to MGC to provide basic local telecommunications services shall become effective on August 7.
