3. Should the Commission grant TC Arkansas a certificate of convenience and necessity with respect to the transmission assets located in Missouri that are to be transferred from EAI to ITC, grant TC Arkansas waivers of 4 CSR 240-3.145, 3.165,

3.175, and 3.190(1)(3), and authorize TC Arkansas to change its name to ITC Arkansas LLC in conjunction with completion of the Transaction?

4. Should the Commission approve a partial transfer of EAI's existing certificate, or issue a new certificate, to Entergy Arkansas LLC to operate its remaining limited distribution facilities in Missouri?






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
