## OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL'S COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION WITHOUT INTERVENTION OF MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and advises the Public Service Commission (PSC) that Public Counsel supports the granting of participation without intervention in this case by the Missouri Department of Economic Development.

Public Counsel supports the inclusion of and input into the PSC process from any interested parties, the public, and the representatives of the public in Missouri, state and local government. Public Counsel believes that inclusion rather than exclusion should be the rule, especially when there is no detriment, unfairness or undue hardship placed on any party.

The Department as a state agency concerned about economic development and an inviting technological environment for business and industry in the state can present concerns about the outcome of this case on economic development which is a different concern and viewpoint from the parties. The Department's comments can provide a

broader context of the pending decision. The Department's request for participation is limited to filing a brief in the case after the hearing in accordance with the briefing schedule. This request is reasonable and will not burden or prejudice any party or unduly burden the proceedings. For these reasons, participation under 4 CSR 240-2.075(5) should be granted.
