Enclosed please find for the Commission's record, the original and four copies of these brief comments of Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. (GCLSI, the Company) as regards the sharing of costs for the 314 Area Code Customer Education Plan.

In principle, GCLSI is opposed to sharing the costs of broadly based, area code customer education plans based on the number of NXX codes a company holds at the time of an area code change. The Company has not been in any of its markets long enough to have fully utilized, or at least utilized to the same extent as most incumbents, its assigned NXX codes. Therefore, the per customer or per line costs of such plans are disproportionately higher for a CLEC like GCLSI than they most likely would be for an incumbent. In comments filed with Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission in a similar proceeding, GCLSI suggested that cost sharing based on NXX code holding is not competitively neutral and amounts to a competition tax.

However, GCLSI has agreed to contribute to the Missouri 314 Customer Education Plans on an NXX basis. The cost and scope of the 314 Plan are more restrained and reasonable than that which the Company has been presented with in the State of Washington and which it may be presented with in other jurisdictions.
