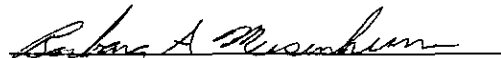

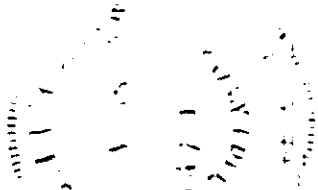

I. INTRODUCTION

Q. PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME, TITLE, AND BUSINESS ADDRESS.

A. Barbara A. Meisenheimer, Chief Utility Economist, Office of the Public Counsel, P. O. Box 7800, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. I am also employed as an adjunct Economics Instructor for William Woods University.

Q. PLEASE SUMMARIZE YOUR EDUCATIONAL AND EMPLOYMENT BACKGROUND.

A. I hold a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics from the University of Missouri-Columbia (UMC) and have completed the comprehensive exams for a Ph.D. in Economics from the same institution. My two fields of study are Quantitative Economics and Industrial Organization. My outside field of study is Statistics. I have taught Economics courses for the following institutions: University of Missouri-Columbia, William Woods University, and Lincoln University. I have taught courses at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

1 **Q. HAVE YOU TESTIFIED PREVIOUSLY BEFORE THIS COMMISSION?**

2 A. Yes, I have testified on numerous issues before the Missouri Public Service Commission.
3 (PSC or Commission)

4 **Q. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY?**

5 A. The primary purpose of my testimony is to present Public Counsel's response to the
6 "industry consensus" proposal (Petition)¹ submitted to the Commission on December 16,
7 1999, by North American Numbering Plan Administrator (Neustar)² and to present Public
8 Counsel's alternative recommendation regarding future area code relief of the 314 and 816
9 area codes. In addition, I will provide evidence supporting our concerns that the historic
10 methods of number assignment and number utilization are plagued by inefficiencies and that
11 by adopting pro-active and aggressive policies the Commission can work to alleviate the
12 cost and inconvenience to Missouri consumers of frequent area code relief. In respond to the
13 Commission's specific inquiry regarding the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC)
14 recent Numbering Order³, I will outline the recently adopted national numbering
15 optimization strategy and suggest number conservation methods consistent with FCC's
16 directives that can empower the Missouri Public Service Commission to promote and
17 achieve meaningful improvements in number utilization.

18 **Q. IN PREPARATION OF YOUR TESTIMONY, WHAT MATERIALS DID YOU REVIEW?**

19 A. I reviewed the Neustar Petition and related materials, including, but not limited to, data
20 request responses provided by Neustar and Missouri telecommunications carriers,

1 numbering utilization and exhaust forecast information obtained from Neustar's web-page,
2 other related and relevant information obtained through informal discussion with interested
3 parties. I also reviewed materials from case TO-98-212 in which the Commission adopted a
4 geographic split for the 314/636 area and initiated number conservation efforts. I reviewed
5 testimony and materials from the public hearings held in this case and attended NASUCA
6 meetings regarding consumer opinions on future area code relief.

7 **Q. WHAT EXPERIENCE HAVE YOU HAD IN CONSIDERING AND ADDRESSING AREA CODE RELIEF**
8 **AND RELATED NUMBERING ISSUES?**

9 **A.** I have testified and submitted testimony as Public Counsel witness before the Missouri PSC
10 on area code relief and number conservation issues and participated in technical committees
11 and workshops during the last 4½ years. On behalf of the Missouri Public Counsel and in
12 conjunction with other state consumer advocates, I participated in drafting comments to the
13 FCC on numbering issues. Since February of this year, I have served as a consumer
14 representative on the North American Numbering Council. As a NANC⁴ member, I have
15 participated in the activities of the entire Council and in a working group assigned to
16 develop materials and recommendations to expand the current North American Numbering
17 Plan⁵ (NANP) in the event of NANP exhaust.

II. OVERVIEW OF PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RECOMMENDATIONS

Q. PLEASE SUMMARIZE PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE TO THE PETITION AND RECOMMENDATION FOR FUTURE AREA CODE RELIEF.

A. Public Counsel believes that it is in the public interest to plan and prepare well in advance of the need for area code relief to minimize consumer's costs, frustration, and inconvenience when the relief plan must actually be implemented. For that reason, Public Counsel does not object to moving forward at this time to plan for the future relief of the 314 and 816 area codes. However, Public Counsel suggests that a key focus of this proceeding should be to establish number conservation methods in order to postpone exhaust. The Petition submitted by Neustar is a flawed relief recommendation and, is an incomplete package because it fails to make any recommendations with respect to postponing exhaust through number conservation efforts. The petition recommends a course of action that would require consumers to continue to shoulder the burden of the inefficient assignment and use of numbering resources. Public Counsel encourages the Commission to continue its efforts to establish number conservation methods and to consider specific relief methods in the context of establishing a "back-up plan."

a. Summary of Number Conservation Recommendations

Public Counsel believes that there are opportunities to extend the life of 314 and 816 through voluntary and mandatory reclamation of unused codes. We recommend that the Commission take immediate action in this area by requesting an update from Neustar regarding the current status of its efforts to reclaim unused codes. In addition, the Commission should require from each code holder (on a one-time basis) a list of any uncontaminated central office codes assigned to the carrier and the date that each code was assigned. This will assist the Commission and NANPA to identify codes that should be

1 reclaimed. I would suggest that the PSC direct the creation of a similar list identifying
2 uncontaminated blocks when pooling become available.

3 The newly established code assignment and usage requirements outlined in the FCC's
4 Numbering Order will significantly alter the methods by which carriers demand and receive
5 codes and has the potential to significantly reduce the rate at which central office codes are
6 depleted. Public Counsel recommends that the Commission obtain and review data on a
7 regular basis in order to fulfill its role to ensure that data submissions are accurate and that
8 codes and blocks are assigned only as necessary. We urge the Commission not to relax the
9 reporting requirement from semi-annual to annual reporting.

10 Public Counsel recommends that the Commission actively pursue the option of
11 implementing a wireless overlay by encouraging reconsideration of this decision by the FCC
12 and by requesting, as other states have done, delegatory authority in this area.

13 We recommend that the Commission continue its efforts in the area of rate center
14 consolidation (RCC) by pursuing more extensive consolidation.

15 Finally, Public Counsel recommends that the Commission continue to pursue authority to
16 conduct pooling trials and to develop a plan for pooling by initiating a technical working
17 group to develop a timeline for trials in 314 and 816, a recommendation regarding selecting
18 a pooling administrator, an estimate of pooling costs, and an implementation plan that is as
19 consistent as possible with the national framework established in the FCC's Order. Public
20 Counsel does not recommend initiating pooling trials in advance of receiving delegatory
21 authority from the FCC. We recommend that the Commission move to initiate state trials
22 only if the Commission is committed to expediting the process and aggressively reclaiming
23 codes.

b. Summary of Relief Recommendations

i. Reject the Retroactive Overlay Proposal for the 636/314 Area Codes

Public Counsel recommends that the Commission reject the retroactive overlay proposal for the 636/314 area codes thereby eliminating any immediate need to consider future relief of the 636 area code. A retroactive overlay would promote the premature exhaust of the newly established 636 area, resulting in additional inconvenience to a group of customers that recently had to change their area code. In addition, contrary to the implications in the Petition, the continued integrity of 911 and E911 services is not dependent on the adoption of a retroactive overlay and should be completely disregarded as a basis for code relief.

ii. 314 Proposal

With respect to future relief in 314, Public Counsel recommends a back-up relief plan to be initiated when the number of assignable central office codes in 314 falls below 90. This proposal will allow the Commission an opportunity to postpone relief through conservation efforts and will allow consumers to retain the benefits of 7-digit dialing for as long as possible. When number conservation no longer allows us to extend the life of the 314 (signaled by the amount of available codes falling below this predetermined level), Public Counsel recognizes that an overlay of the 314 area code may then be the only reasonable alternative.

Public Counsel's acquiescence to the overlay of 314 should not be viewed as a significant change in the Office's policy regarding area code relief. Instead, it should be viewed as Public Counsel's recognition that carving up the already small 314 area into smaller pieces in order to retain a geographic identity and 7 digit dialing does not produce sufficient benefit to outweigh the inconvenience of making customers change their area code.

iii. 816 Proposal

With respect to 816, Public Counsel believes that the Commission should postpone the final decision on the specific type of relief to adopt. The Commission should require the industry to develop contingency plans to implement either a geographic split roughly along the Missouri River or an overlay of the entire 816 area.

The current 816 area is still relatively large and is split fairly evenly by a natural geographic boundary, the Missouri River. If the frequency of geographic splits could be substantially reduced through number conservation, then a geographic split along the river is a preferred method for area code relief. However, number conservation methods are currently in their infancy and it will take time to determine whether the new optimization strategies can be implemented in time to substantially extend the life of the proposed geographic split.

Public Counsel suggests that the Commission keep this case open and postpone its final consideration and decision until the number of assignable codes falls below 100.

c. Current Prohibition on Wireless Overlays

Currently, the FCC prohibits the use of technology specific overlays. However, there is a possibility that the FCC will reconsider its position. Public Counsel encourages the Commission to consider adopting a "wireless overlay" instead of an "all services overlay" as the method of back-up relief, if time permits, in the event that the FCC's lifts its current prohibition on technology specific overlays.

III. NUMBERING RESOURCES

Q. Please describe the current North American Numbering Plan.

A. Under its current configuration, a typical phone number is a 10 digit number of the form NPA - NXX -XXXX. The first three digits represent the "Numbering Plan Area" more commonly known as the "area code." The next three digits represent the "NXX" or "central office" code and the final four digits represent the "station" or "customer line" number. From a mathematicians point of view, each of these digits could be assigned one of 10 possible values from the set (0, 1, 2,...9) producing in total $10*10*10*10*10*10*10*10*10*10 = 10$ billion possible combinations of numbering arrangements. However, under the current North American Numbering Plan, there are some limitations on what values certain digits can be assigned. For example, current public policy and switching capabilities restrict the first digit of the NPA and the first digit of the central office code from assuming a value of either "0" or "1" because when these are the first digits dialed it indicates to the switching equipment that the call is a toll call or a call to a local operator. Another familiar type of limitation is that some arrangements of the first three digits dialed have special meanings to the switch. For example, when the first three digits dialed are "911" the switch recognizes and processes the call as an emergency call.

Assigning the first three digit of the 10 digit combination specific values, as is done when Missouri is assigned a specific area code, limits the maximum possible combinations within that area code to $10*10*10*10*10*10*10 = 10$ million potential numbering arrangements made up of $10*10*10=1000$ possible combinations for the central office code and a $10*10*10*10=10,000$ station number block associated with each of the central office codes. As I indicated before, there are limitations on certain combinations that can be initially dialed. The 8 central office codes per NPA that end in "11" are designated for

1 emergency, directory, and other dialing arrangements. Excluding these, there are about 792
2 remaining NXXs available for assignment to requesting telecommunications companies. Of
3 the 792, there are some central office codes that are designated by carriers for specific
4 purposes such as testing or administration. After accounting for such uses there are
5 approximately 750 central office codes, each associated with a 10,000 block of station
6 numbers that remain and are available to carriers for assignment to their end-users. This
7 translates into approximately 7.5 million assignable 7-digit telephone numbers for each of
8 Missouri's 6 area codes.

9 **a. Availability and Assignment of Central Office Codes**

10 **Q. HOW ARE NUMBERS CURRENTLY ASSIGNED IN MISSOURI?**

11 **A.** In Missouri, the Number Administrator currently assigns a requesting telecommunications
12 company a central office code and the associated block of 10,000 numbers. In the future, we
13 will transition to an environment in which the 10,000 numbers associated with a particular
14 central office code will be treated as a pool from which carriers will be assigned a smaller
15 subset of numbers.

16 **Q. HOW MANY CENTRAL OFFICE CODES ARE CURRENTLY UNAVAILABLE AND HOW MANY**
17 **CODES ARE STILL AVAILABLE FOR ASSIGNMENT?**

18 Table 1. identifies the number of codes that are reported as unavailable and available
19 according to information posted on Neustar's webpage. In addition, to those codes tracked
20 by Neustar, there are 200 potential combinations beginning with either "0" or "1" that
21 Neustar does not report.

Q. HAVE YOU PROVIDED A LISTING OF THE CODES THAT NEUSTAR IDENTIFIES AS AVAILABLE AND UNAVAILABLE?

A. Yes, I have. The codes that Neustar identifies as available are listed by area code in Schedule BAM-1. I have provided a copy of the portions of Neustar's database that identify unavailable codes in the 314, 636 and 816 area codes as Schedule BAM-2, Schedule BAM-3 and Schedule BAM-4. I have also summarized the assigned codes by rate center in Schedule BAM-5.

Q. WHY MIGHT CERTAIN CODES BE LISTED AS UNAVAILABLE IN NESTER'S DATABASE?

A. The primary reason a code might be listed as unavailable is that it has been assigned and is in use by a telecommunications carrier or that the code has been assigned but has not yet been activated in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG). Another reason is that the code may be designated for some special use such as testing, administration, directory or emergency services. Table 2. identifies the currently unavailable codes by use. Codes that are designated for some special use such as testing, administration, directory or emergency services are not assigned an identifier in Neustar's data file, so I have categorized them as having an "unidentified use."

Q. DO YOU BELIEVE THAT SOME OF THE CODES IDENTIFIED BY NEUSTAR AS UNAVAILABLE SHOULD NOW OR SHOULD SOON BE AVAILABLE FOR ASSIGNMENT?

A. Yes, I do. In reviewing data request responses from Neustar, I was able to verify that the number of unidentified codes for 314 in Neustar's database roughly matched the combined number of test, "1-1" and other special codes currently being used in 314. It is not clear this is true for the unidentified codes in the 816 area code where the number of unavailable codes with an unidentified use appeared substantially higher. My belief is that approximately 17 of the unidentified codes for 816 are codes that have been returned from TCG and Mid-Missouri Cellular that should now or soon be available for assignment. In addition, I am not aware of any reason that the number of tests and special use codes in 816 should be substantially higher than in 314. So even after accounting for the 17 codes, it seems to me that there may be in the neighborhood of 15 more codes listed as unidentified by Neustar that are unaccounted for. It may be these codes have been reserved for some future, but unidentified use. I have submitted additional data requests to Neustar to determine if some of these remaining codes should be categorized as available.

1 **Q. WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF RECLASSIFYING THESE CODES AS AVAILABLE?**

2 A. Accurately gauging the quantity of the currently or soon to be available codes is critical in
3 providing the Commission a complete picture from which to make decisions about how long
4 the 816 area code will actually last. In addition, it is important in determining when relief
5 planning or code rationing should actually begin. For example, I am estimating future code
6 demand in 816 at 7 codes per month. At that rate, 17 additional available codes would
7 extend the forecasted life of 816 by over 24 months. If the number of additional available
8 codes is closer to 35 then the forecast life of 816 could be extended by 5 months

9 **Q. DO YOU BELIEVE THAT THERE ARE OPPORTUNITIES TO RECOVER SOME OF THE**
10 **UNAVAILABLE CODES THAT HAVE ALREADY BEEN ASSIGNED TO CARRIERS?**

11 A. Yes, I do. I believe that there are opportunities to reclaim codes from carriers that do not
12 need them. In some cases we may be able to regain unused codes on a voluntary basis. If
13 not, the FCC's recent Order establishes a procedure through which states have the authority
14 to reclaim codes on a mandatory basis. I will discuss the FCC's new procedure and
15 evidence on the potential benefits of aggressive code reclamation later in this testimony.

16 **b. Expected Rate of Exhaust of Available Codes and Exhaust Projections**

17 **Q. HOW RAPIDLY WILL THE AVAILABLE 314 AND 816 CENTRAL OFFICE CODES BE DEPLETED?**

18 A. That is a difficult question. Based on the most recent COCUS Projection available on
19 Neustar's website, I estimate that Neustar is forecasting the rate of exhaust for 314 at about
20 11.6 codes per month for 314 and about 10.2 codes per month for 816. However, as
21 illustrated in Schedule BAM-6 the rate Neustar projected for both 314 and 816 in the
22 January update of the December, 1999, report appears to have fallen since the April, 1999,

1 report indicating a potentially declining trend in Neustar's forecast. The historic rates of
2 code assignment have been lower in part because of reduced assignments during jeopardy.

3 Considering both the historic rate and the Neustar projections, I am comfortable with
4 working with a 10 code per month estimate for 314 and a 7 code per month estimate for 816,
5 although I think there are some factors that could impact these estimates.

6 **Q. WHAT FACTORS MIGHT ALTER THE FUTURE RATES OF CODE ASSIGNMENT?**

7 A. The FCC's new requirements for code requests, all else equal, should decrease the rate of
8 code assignments. However, I would not be surprised to see the code assignments rise in
9 816 and possibly 636 over the next two or three months if carriers attempt to "stock up"
10 before the FCC's Order takes full effect.

11 **Q. YOU PREVIOUSLY STATED THAT THERE MAY BE OPPORTUNITIES TO RECLAIM AND**
12 **RECLASSIFY CODES THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY UNAVAILABLE FOR ASSIGNMENT. COULD**
13 **THIS HAVE AN IMPACT ON THE ACTUAL EXHAUST DATE?**

14 A. Yes, it could. I believe that the largest benefits from reclaiming and reclassifying codes can
15 be achieved for the 816 area code where it appears that somewhere between 17 and 33
16 central office codes could eventually be reclassified.

17 **Q. PLEASE COMPARE THE RATE OF EXHAUST AND THE PROJECTED EXHAUST DATE UNDER**
18 **VARIOUS SCENARIOS.**

19 A. Tables 3.1 and 3.2 illustrate the rates of exhaust I previously discussed and the resulting
20 exhaust projection. The final column in each table reflects reclamation of 10 central office
21 codes each for 314 and 816. In addition, the final column for 816 reflects an adjustment that
22 brings the number of unidentified use codes in 816 more in line with the number of those

codes reported for 314. I previously discussed why I believe such an adjustment may be reasonable.

c. Current Utilization of Assigned Codes

Q. HAS PUBLIC COUNSEL CONDUCTED A NUMBER UTILIZATION STUDY FOR THE 314, 636 AND 816 AREA CODES?

A. Yes, we have.

Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE THE STUDY SAMPLE.

A. The sample on which our study is based includes data provided by the 23 code holders that responded to Public Counsel's data requests. A list of the carriers responding to our survey is provided as Schedule BAM-7. I would estimate that our study results reflect information about telephone number utilization in approximately 70% of the combined central office codes assigned in 314, 636 and 816. The portion of these telephone numbers reported from individual area codes ranges between 65% and 75%.

Q. PLEASE PROVIDE A SUMMARY OF THE SURVEY RESULTS.

A. Table 4.1 illustrates number utilization results for all carriers operating within each area code as well as the utilization results for the combined sample. Table 4.2 illustrates the combined sample results for different types of carriers.

2 Some of the carriers that responded to our data requests expressed concern that they
3 considered more granular data than that illustrated in Table 4.1 and 4.2 to be confidential
4 information. Although Public Counsel does not necessarily agree with this characterization,
5 I have treated the summary of the more granular survey results as confidential. This
6 information is provided in Schedule BAM-8HC.

7 The level of detailed utilization data that Public Counsel obtained would allow us to report
8 each carrier's utilization for each thousand block within a particular rate center. I reviewed
9 this data and will provide general observations about the information. However, at the
10 request of some of the carriers that provided the survey data I have not included schedules in
11 my testimony that disclose this level of detail.

12 **Q. WHAT ARE YOUR GENERAL OBSERVATIONS ABOUT THE SURVEY RESULTS?**

13 **A.** Even in the most geographically compact area code 314, carriers are using only about 63%
14 of the numbering resources that they have been assigned. For 816, carriers are using only
15 about 50%.

16 In less densely populated rate centers, utilization tends to be much lower than in more
17 populated rate centers. However, there is substantial variation in the rate of utilization by
18 carrier and by rate center in the more urban areas.

19 There is a requirement for landline carriers to have at least one code per rate center (two if
20 they offer MCA). This requirement should work to reduce the combined utilization rate.
21 The study results appear to support this conclusion. This requirement as it applies to ILECs
22 serving less densely populated rate centers does appear to impact the carriers individual

1 usage rate as well as the combined rate. The 1-2 code requirement on CLEC utilization also
2 tended to pull down the overall use rates in more urban rate centers.

3 A common argument is that wireless carriers are more efficient because they can serve
4 multiple landline rate centers out of a single switch. However, the study indicates that,
5 despite their potential ability to use numbers more efficiently than LECs, they do not
6 necessarily do so. In fact, an ILEC has the highest utilization rate for each area code among
7 all the carriers reporting.

8 **Q. HOW MANY UNCONTAMINATED CENTRAL OFFICE CODES WERE REPORTED?**

9 A. In 314, there were 45 central office codes from which no numbers have been assigned.
10 There were 23 of such codes in 816. In some cases a carrier has multiple unused central
11 office codes in the same rate center.

12 **Q. DID THERE APPEAR TO BE A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF UNCONTAMINATED THOUSAND**
13 **BLOCKS CONTAINED IN THE CONTAMINATED CENTRAL OFFICE CODES?**

14 A. Yes. In 314 contaminated central office codes, there were 463 unused thousands-blocks. In
15 816, there were 933. I should point out that the number of unused central office codes and
16 thousands-blocks does not include any that were not reported.
17

IV. THE FCC NUMBERING ORDER

a. Overview of the Numbering Order

Q. WHAT NUMBERING OPTIMIZATION STRATEGIES HAS THE FCC ADOPTED IN THE MARCH 31, 2000 NUMBERING ORDER?

A. The first strategy adopted by the FCC is to establish by rule uniform definitions to be used by carriers and to require mandatory usage reporting. Secondly, the FCC requires a carrier to demonstrate that it is operational or near operational before receiving initial resources and that it has achieved a threshold utilization rate, and can demonstrate need before receiving growth resources. The FCC also requires carriers to sequentially assign numbers. The FCC adopts procedures by which unused numbering resources can be reclaimed. Finally, the FCC establishes a national framework for mandatory number pooling by LNP capable carriers including large LECS and covered CMRS providers. The national roll out will be phased in initially in the top 100 MSAs on a quarterly basis beginning 9 months after the selection of a Pooling Administrator. In the interim, the FCC will continue to grant delegated authority to states to conduct pooling trials.

b. Uniform Definitions and Mandatory Usage Reporting Requirements

Q. HOW WILL NUMBERS BE CATEGORIZED UNDER THE FCC RULES?

A. A carrier's resources will be classified into six primary categories and eight secondary categories of numbering use. The primary categories are Assigned, Intermediate, Reserved, Aging, Administrative, and Available.

1 **Q. WHAT ARE THE REPORTING REQUIRMENTS?**

2 A. All central office code holders that receive numbering resources from the NANPA or block
3 holders that receive numbering resources from a Pooling Administrator will be required to
4 report forecast and utilization data to the NANPA. Carriers that receive Intermediate
5 Numbers are required to report forecast and utilization data for such numbers in their
6 inventories to the NANPA to the same extent required for code and block holders. The FCC
7 authorizes rural telephone companies to report their historical utilization data at the NXX
8 level rather than at the thousand-block level in areas where Local Number Portability (LNP)
9 is not available.

10 **Q. WHAT MECHANISM WILL ENSURE THAT A CARRIER REPORTS ITS USAGE AND FORECAST**
11 **DATA AND THAT THE DATA WILL BE ACCURATE?**

12 A. The FCC requires NANPA to examine each data submission for inconsistencies or
13 anomalies and to attempt to resolve discrepancies through discussions with the carrier. If
14 NANPA preliminarily concludes that the submission is insufficient, then the NANPA shall
15 report the finding to the state commission and to the Common Carrier Bureau. The states are
16 delegated the authority to make a determination on the validity of the data and to instruct the
17 carrier on how any deficiencies should be remedied. The NANPA shall not assign
18 additional resources to that carrier until the appropriate state commission has resolved all
19 questions regarding the inconsistency or anomaly. In cases where a carrier fails to provide its
20 utilization and forecast information, the NANPA is required to withhold numbering
21 resources until the information is provided.

22 **Q. HOW OFTEN WILL CARRIERS REPORT?**

23 A. Reporting will occur semi-annually unless a state commission authorizes annual reporting.

1 **Q. DO YOU RECOMMEND THAT THE MISSOURI COMMISSION RELAX THE REQUIREMENT TO**
2 **ANNUAL REPORTING?**

3 A. Absolutely not. Up to date information is necessary to gauge the impact of number
4 conservation methods and to predict how long our existing resources will last. Under the
5 FCC's Numbering Order, state commissions will have the authority to order NANPA to
6 reclaim codes. More frequent reporting will aid the PSC in this effort.

7 **Q. WHEN WILL CARRIERS BEGIN REPORTING?**

8 A. All carriers will file their first report by August 1, 2000.

9 **Q. WHAT LEVEL OF DETAIL WILL THE REPORTS CONTAIN?**

10 A. Historical utilization data will be reported at the NPA level. In pooling areas, forecast data
11 shall be reported at the thousands-block per rate center level for pooling carriers and at the
12 NXX level per rate center for non-pooling carriers. In non-pooling areas, forecast data shall
13 be reported at the NXX per NPA level.

14 **Q. WHAT DATA WILL STATES HAVE ACCESS TO?**

15 A. Subject to appropriate confidentiality protections, states will have access to the semi-
16 annually reported data through NANPA or may request it directly from the carrier. States
17 may also gather more granular data from a carrier for a specific purpose, as long as the
18 reporting does not become regularly scheduled at the state level.

c. Demonstration of Need for Numbering Resources

Q. HOW WILL REQUESTING CARRIERS DEMONSTRATE A NEED FOR AN INITIAL RESOURCE ALLOCATION?

A. The carrier must provide evidence demonstrating that it is licensed and/or certified to provide service in the area in which it seeks initial numbers and a showing that equipment has been purchased and is operational or will be operational within 60 days of the numbering resources activation date. The requirements apply to carriers requesting either an initial NXX code or thousands-block.

Q. HOW WILL A REQUESTING CARRIERS DEMONSTRATE A NEED FOR GROWTH RESOURCES?

A. Non-pooling carriers seeking growth resources must achieve a threshold utilization level, calculated by dividing the assigned numbers by the carriers total numbers and then multiplying the result by 100. The FCC is still considering what specific utilization threshold should be required.

d. Nationwide Mandatory Pooling

Q. WHAT IS NUMBER POOLING?

A. Number pooling allows NXXs to be associated with a particular geographic area instead of a particular telecommunications carrier. Carriers that participate in number pooling in an area can share numbers from the NXXs assigned to that area.

1 **Q. WHAT IS A "THOUSANDS-BLOCK?"**

2 A. A thousands-block refers to the subset of 7-digit telephone numbers generated by fixing the
3 3-digit central office code number and the first digit of the 4-digit station number. For
4 example, my 7-digit telephone number is 751-5567. It is one of the blocks of 1,000 numbers
5 from 751-5000 to 751-5999.

6 **Q. WHICH CARRIERS WILL PARTICIPATE IN MANDATORY THOUSANDS-BLOCK NUMBER**
7 **POOLING?**

8 A. All carriers that are LNP-capable will participate. This means that covered CMRS providers
9 will be required to implement thousands-block number pooling on or after November 24,
10 2002

11 **Q. WHEN IS NATIONWIDE POOLING SCHEDULED TO BEGIN?**

12 Q. The national roll out is to be phased in, initially in the top 100 MSAs, on a quarterly basis
13 beginning 9 months after the selection of a Pooling Administrator. In the interim, the FCC
14 will continue to grant delegated authority to states to conduct pooling trials.

15 **Q. HOW WILL A POOLING ADMINISTRATOR BE SELECTED?**

16 A. The Pooling Administrator will be selected through a competitive bid process.

17 **Q. HOW WILL NUMBER POOLS BE ESTABLISHED INITIALLY?**

18 A. There will be a thousands-block pool for each rate center containing a six month inventory
19 of numbers. After retaining an initial block and a sufficient number of thousands-blocks to
20 meet its six-month projection forecast, carriers must donate all thousands-blocks that have a

1 less than ten-percent contamination level to the thousands-block number pool for the rate
2 center.

3 **Q. HOW WILL NUMBER POOLING BE PHASED IN?**

4 A. Thousands-block number pooling will first occur in NPAs that are located in the largest 100
5 MSAs. Each quarter three NPAs from each of the seven NPAC regions will begin pooling.

6 **Q. HOW WILL THE FCC PRIORITIZE NPAs IN ESTABLISHING A ROLL OUT SCHEDULE?**

7 A. The determinations of which NPAs should be placed on the initial rollout schedule will be
8 based on: 1) NPAs that were initially pooled or scheduled to be pooled pursuant to
9 delegations of pooling authority to a state commission; 2) jeopardy NPAs in the largest 100
10 MSAs which have a life of one year or more; 3) new NPAs. NPAs that will exhaust in less
11 than a year will not be treated as priority NPAs for pooling purposes. States may choose to
12 opt out of the roll out schedule on a temporary basis or petition the FCC to opt in to the
13 national pooling roll out schedule.

14 A state choosing to opt in must demonstrate that: 1) an NPA in its state is in jeopardy, 2) the
15 NPA in question has a remaining a life span of at least a year, and 3) the majority of wireline
16 carriers in the NPA are LNP-capable. The FCC will also consider state requests to opt in to
17 the national pooling rollout schedule where a state demonstrates special circumstances. The
18 FCC will also permit state commissions to substitute the NPA listed in the rollout schedule
19 with an alternative NPA.

e. Continuation of State Pooling Trials

Q. WILL THE FCC CONTINUE TO GRANT STATES AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT THOUSANDS-BLOCK NUMBER POOLING ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS?

A. Yes. However, states must conform with the national framework by September 1, 2000.

Q. WHAT ARE THE FCC ESTABLISHED GUIDELINES FOR PETITIONS SEEKING AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT POOLING TRIALS?

A. Each petition must demonstrate that: 1) an NPA in its state is in jeopardy, 2) the NPA in question has a remaining life span of at least a year, and 3) that NPA is in one of the largest 100 MSAs, or alternatively, the majority of wireline carriers in the NPA are LNP-capable.

f. Carriers are Required to Sequentially Assign Numbers

Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE THE REQUIREMENT FOR CARRIERS TO SEQUENTIALLY ASSIGN NUMBERS.

A. Carriers must first assign all available telephone numbers within an opened thousands-block before opening another one, unless the available numbers in the block are not sufficient to meet a customer request. A carrier that opens a clean block prior to filling the previous block may be required to demonstrate to the state commission: (1) a genuine request from a customer detailing the specific need for telephone numbers; (2) the inability on the part of the carrier to satisfy the request out of the open block.

Q. IS THE FCC REQUIRING RATE CENTER CONSOLIDATION?

A. No, it is not. The FCC recognizes that states should have authority over rate center consolidation.

1 **Q. WHAT IS A RATE CENTER?**

2 A. A rate center is a geographic point identified by a V&H coordinate.

3 **Q. WHAT IS A RATE AREA AND HOW DOES THE NUMBER OF RATE AREAS EFFECT THE NEED**
4 **FOR NXXs?**

5 A. A rate area is a geographic area for which a single rate center is used for measuring and
6 billing long distance calls. Even though competitive local exchange companies are allowed
7 to identify their own local calling scopes, if they are facilities-based, they may need a
8 primary NXX for each of the incumbent local exchange company's rate areas in which they
9 offer services to ensure consistency in the measurement and billing of toll calls.

10 **Q. WHAT IS RATE AREA CONSOLIDATION?**

11 A. Rate area or rate center consolidation (RCC) facilitates reducing the number of rate areas by
12 expanding the geographic boundaries associated with a rate center.

13 **Q. WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF RCC?**

14 A. RCC can improve the utilization of our existing number resources in two ways. It can
15 enhance the effectiveness of pooling and it will, all else equal, reduce the total number of
16 codes needed by new entrants.

V. COMPARISON OF THE AVAILABLE OPTIONS

a. Postponing Relief Through Number Conservation is the Best Option

Q. WHY IS NUMBER CONSERVATION IMPORTANT?

A. Changes in area code assignments produce customer confusion, inconvenience, and dissatisfaction related to changing dialing patterns. They also result in lost revenue by businesses and additional costs to both households and firms such as modifications to business cards, stationary, and telecommunications equipment or other devices linked to that equipment. Through the implementation of effective number conservation methods, we may be able to forestall unpopular and costly relief measures.

b. Geographic Splits are Generally Preferable to All Service Overlays

i. The Convenience of Seven-Digit Dialing Within The Local Calling Scope

Q. WHY DO YOU BELIEVE THAT A GEOGRAPHIC SPLIT IS GENERALLY PREFERABLE TO AN ALL SERVICE OVERLAY?

A. I believe that retaining seven-digit dialing for as long as possible for basic local subscribers is truly in the public interest. In addition to the convenience it affords to the typical caller, it provides an additional level of benefit to those callers with difficulty remembering or dialing numbers. Implementation of an all service overlay would require ten-digit dialing for every local call placed within an NPA despite the fact that local calling scopes will remain the same. Another significant downfall of the mandatory ten-digit dialing required under an all service overlay proposal is that it will no longer be possible to easily distinguish between local and toll calls and, in fact, may act to desensitize callers to the distinction.

ii. Identifiable Geographic Regions

Q. WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF MATCHING AREA CODES WITH A SPECIFIC GEOGRAPHIC REGION?

A. Traditionally, an area code has been identified as matched to a specific geographic region. One of the benefits of this matching is that a caller without access to a local directory can dial 1-NPA-555-1212 to obtain directory information about a particular community within the area. Splits tend to refine the geographic boundaries improving the ability of callers unfamiliar with an area to identify and obtain relevant directory information. The overlay proposal undermines this process.

iii. Overlay Codes Stigmatize New Businesses and New Local Service Providers

Q. IS THERE A STIGMA ATTACHED TO RECEIVING OR PROVIDING NUMBERS FROM THE OVERLAY CODE?

A. It is possible that as residential and business subscribers require additional lines, the new numbers will have an area code different than the subscribers existing lines. This is likely to be a very undesirable byproduct of adopting an overlay. For example, established businesses usually rely on reputation and length of service to the community to grow their customer base. They may be hesitant to add additional lines to either new or existing offices that carry the overlay area code because they fear customers may perceive a correlation between the newness of the area code and the newness of their business. Receiving only lines assigned to the new area code will discriminate against start up companies to the extent that consumers actually do identify the newness of the area code with the newness of the business. Subscribers attempting to avoid assignment of the new area code will be more

1 likely to obtain service from an incumbent LEC than from a new LSP since incumbent local
2 exchange companies will control a disproportionate share of numbers assigned in an
3 exhausting code. Adopting the overlay proposal guarantees that new LSP will face an
4 unlevel playing field as they attempt to compete.

5 **iv. Overlays Limit Future Relief Options**

6 **Q. IF THE COMMISSION ADOPTS AN ALL SERVICE OVERLAY HOW DOES IT LIMIT WHAT TYPE**
7 **OF RELIEF OPTIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE FUTURE?**

8 A. Implementing an all service overlay now essentially precludes the future use of any other
9 type of relief other than another overlay. By adopting a geographic split, the Commission
10 ensures that it will have no less options available when future number exhaustion relief plans
11 are necessary.

12 **VI. RESPONSE TO THE PETITION AND RELIEF RECOMMENDATIONS**

13 **i. A Retroactive Overlay is Unnecessary and is Bad Public Policy**

14 **Q. WHAT TYPE OF RELIEF FOR THE 314 AREA CODE IS SUGGESTED IN THE PETITION?**

15 A. The suggested relief is to create a retroactive overlay of 636 onto 314. Effectively this
16 would allow codes to be borrowed from the 636 supply and assigned in 314.

17 **Q. UNDER THE PROPOSAL WOULD IT BE POSSIBLE TO ASSIGN 314 CODES IN THE 636 AREA?**

18 A. I believe that it would.

1 **Q. HOW WILL THE PROPOSAL IMPACT CONSUMERS IN 636?**

2 A. I believe it treats them unreasonably and unfairly. The proposal is unreasonable because it is
3 unnecessary from a technical perspective. In addition, it is patently unfair. In the previous
4 314 relief case, the customers in 636 retained 7-digit dialing in their local exchange in
5 exchange for changing their area code. Under a retroactive overlay, these customers would
6 be forced into mandatory 10-digit dialing despite their recent area code change. This further
7 burdens these customers that have already paid the price of inefficient code use and code
8 assignment because of growth primarily occurring in what is the new 314 area.

9 **Q. WOULD THE PROPOSAL DEplete THE SUPPLY OF 636 CENTRAL OFFICE CODES?**

10 A. Yes, it would. The proposal would deplete the supply of codes in 636 in 4.4 years according
11 to Neustar's projection at which time relief would be necessary for 636 as well as 314.

12 **Q. IS THIS ALTERNATIVE PREFERABLE TO AN OVERLAY OF JUST THE 314 AREA?**

13 A. No, it is not. Neustar projects that by overlaying only 314, 314 would have enough codes
14 for 6.3 years. This option would yield more life for 314 without burdening 636 with
15 mandatory 10-digit dialing or premature exhaust.

16 **Q. ON PAGE 3 OF THE PETITION IT IS SUGGESTED THAT A RETROACTIVE OVERLAY IS**
17 **NECESSARY BECAUSE OTHER RELIEF OPTIONS WOULD NOT ALLOW SUFFICIENT TIME FOR**
18 **911 SYSTEMS TO BE UPGRADED TO ACCEPT ANOTHER NPA CODE. IS THIS CORRECT?**

19 A. No. In response to inquiries by Public Counsel and the Commission's Staff, SWBT has
20 further investigated this concern and confirmed that a geographic split or overlay can be
21 implemented without jeopardizing 911 or E-911 service.

ii. **314 Proposal**

Q. WHAT IS PUBLIC COUNSEL'S PROPOSAL FOR THE 314 AREA CODE?

A. With respect to future relief in 314, Public Counsel recommends a back-up relief plan to be initiated when the number of assignable central office codes in 314 falls below 90. When number conservation does not allow us to further extend the life of the 314 (signaled by the amount of available codes falling below this predetermined level) Public Counsel will accept an overlay of the 314 area code under the circumstances.

Q. WHY WOULD THIS APPROACH BE BENEFICIAL?

A. This proposal will allow the Commission an opportunity to postpone relief through conservation efforts and will allow consumers to retain the benefits of 7-digit dialing for as long as possible.

Q. WHY DO YOU BELIEVE THAT 90 CODES IS A REASONABLE THRESHOLD?

A. The historic rate of code usage and Neustar's projected rate indicate that about 10-12 codes are assigned each month. In addition, I believe that the FCC order will tend to reduce the rate of code assignments. Estimating usage at 10 codes per month allows 9 months to implement an overlay including a 6-month permissive dialing period. If the plan is preapproved by the Commission and the industry is prepared in advance, I believe that 9 months is an adequate time frame to implement an overlay.

1 Q. SHOULD PUBLIC COUNSEL'S ACQUIESCENCE TO AN EVENTUAL OVERLAY OF 314 BE
2 VIEWED AS A SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN ITS POLICY REGARDING AREA CODE RELIEF?

3 A. No. Instead, it should be viewed as a rational recognition that carving up the already small
4 314 area into smaller pieces in order to retain a geographic identity and 7-digit dialing does
5 not produce sufficient benefits to outweigh the inconvenience of making customers change
6 their area code.

7 Q. WILL NUMBER CONSERVATION SIGNIFICANTLY EXTEND THE LIFE OF THE 314?

8 A. I'm not sure. For this reason, we should consider an overlay relief plan. Many of the
9 number conservation methods Public Counsel recommended in the previous case are just
10 beginning to be implemented. I am hopeful that the FCC's requirement that carriers
11 demonstrate a need for codes before they can receive them will slow down the rate of
12 exhaust. I also believe that by reclaiming codes on both a voluntary and mandatory basis we
13 can extend the life of 314. I believe that there is a possibility that we may be able to extend
14 the life of 314 even longer if pooling can be implemented.

15 iii. 816 Proposal

16 Q. WHAT IS PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RECOMMENDATION FOR THE 816 AREA CODE?

17 A. Public Counsel recommends that the Commission postpone the final decision on the specific
18 type of relief needed in 816 until the number of assignable codes falls below 100. The
19 Commission should require the industry to develop plans to implement either a geographic
20 split roughly along the Missouri River or an overlay of the entire 816 area.

1 Q. WHY WOULD THIS APPROACH BE BENEFICIAL?

2 A. I believe that there is a much greater chance of extending the initial life of 816.
3 Additionally, if number conservation proves effective in substantially extending the life of a
4 geographic split, then the traditional advantages of choosing a split over an overlay can be
5 preserved.

6 Q. WHY DO YOU BELIEVE THAT 100 CODES IS A REASONABLE THRESHOLD?

7 A. The historic rate of code usage and Neustar's projected rate indicate that about 7-10 codes
8 are assigned each month. In addition, I believe that the FCC order will tend to reduce the
9 rate of code assignments. Estimating usage at 7 codes per month allows 14 months for the
10 Commission to choose an overlay or a split and to implement the relief, including a 6 month
11 permissive dialing period. I estimate that this gives us about 13 months to determine the
12 potential benefits of number conservation.

13 Q. WHY DO YOU BELIEVE THAT A GEOGRAPHIC SPLIT MIGHT BE A REASONABLE
14 ALTERNATIVE TO AN OVERLAY OF 816?

15 A. The current 816 area is still relatively large and is split fairly evenly by a natural geographic
16 boundary, the Missouri River. If the expected life of a geographic split could be
17 substantially reduced through number conservation, then a geographic split along the river
18 would be the preferred method for area code relief. Given the lower demand for codes in
19 816, we have some latitude to wait and see. Public Counsel suggests that the PSC take this
20 approach rather than adopt Neustar's industry recommendation.

VII. NUMBER CONSERVATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Q. WHAT IS YOUR RECOMMENDATION REGARDING UNUSED CODES?

A. We recommend that the Commission take immediate and aggressive action in this area by requesting an update from Neustar on the current status of its efforts to reclaim unused codes. In addition, the Commission should require from each code holder (on a one-time basis) a list of any uncontaminated central office codes assigned to the carrier and the date that each code was assigned. I would suggest that the PSC require a similar list identifying uncontaminated blocks when pooling become available.

Q. WHY IS IT NECESSARY TO OBTAIN INFORMATION FROM NEUSTAR AND CARRIERS ABOUT UNUSED CODES?

A. Obtaining information from Neustar about its reclamation efforts is an appropriate way to gain an understanding of where we stand in the process. It will also give us an idea of how aggressive past efforts have been. Immediately obtaining a list of unused codes from the code holders would allow us to begin this process before the August 1, 2000, reporting date. It is important to know the date the code was assigned because we may be able to reclaim codes that are unused beyond 8 months. For some assigned but unused codes I believe the process could potentially begin as soon as the FCC's Order becomes effective. One example might be the 9 codes in 314 and 8 codes in 816 held by Digital Teleport Inc. Based on the status of CLEC applications for certification, interconnection/resale agreements and tariffs as of 3/07/00 from the Commission's website, Digital Teleport Inc. obtained approval for interconnections in the 1997 to 1998 timeframe but does not have approved tariffs.

1 It may be difficult to identify the actual number of codes a carrier has because in some cases
2 they control codes listed under multiple names (such as after a merger). This is another
3 reason why this information would be extremely helpful in identifying reclaimable codes.

4 **Q. WHAT IS PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RECOMMENDATION REGARDING REVIEW OF UTILIZATION**
5 **AND FORECAST DATA?**

6 A. We recommend that the Commission obtain and review data on a regular basis in order to
7 fulfill its role in ensuring that data submissions are accurate and codes and blocks are only
8 assigned as necessary. In addition, we urge the Commission not to relax the reporting
9 requirement from semi-annual to annual reporting.

10 **Q. WHAT IS YOUR RECOMMENDATION WITH RESPECT TO WIRELESS OVERLAYS?**

11 A. Public Counsel recommends that the Commission revisit this option if there is time. The
12 Commission should actively pursue the option of implementing a wireless overlay by
13 encouraging FCC reconsideration and by requesting delegated authority in this area as other
14 states have done.

15 **Q. WHY WOULD THIS BE BENEFICIAL?**

16 A. Based on consumer input Public Counsel has received at public hearings, in consumer letters
17 and telephone conversations, this seems to be a popular alternative to splits and all service
18 overlays. In addition, since wireless carriers tend to offer service out of urban wirecenters,
19 this method of relief would be effective in providing relief in areas that need it the most.

1 **Q. WHAT IS YOUR RECOMMENDATION REGARDING RATE CENTER CONSOLIDATION?**

2 A. We recommend that the Commission continue its efforts in the area of rate center
3 consolidation by encouraging voluntary consolidation. We also suggest that the
4 Commission investigate more extensive consolidation in urban areas perhaps on a
5 mandatory basis.

6 **Q. WHAT IS YOUR RECOMMENDATION REGARDING POOLING TRIALS?**

7 A. Public Counsel recommends that the Commission continue to pursue authority to conduct
8 pooling trials. The PSC should develop a plan for pooling by initiating a technical working
9 group to develop a timeline for trials in 314 and 816, a recommendation regarding selecting
10 a pooling administrator, an estimate of pooling costs, and an implementation plan that is as
11 consistent as possible with the national framework established in the FCC's Order. Public
12 Counsel does not recommend initiating pooling trials in advance of receiving delegated
13 authority from the FCC. Finally, we recommend that the Commission move to initiate state
14 trials in advance of the nationwide roll out only if the Commission is committed to
15 expediting the process and aggressively reclaiming codes.

16 **Q. WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THIS RECOMMENDATION?**

17 A. Moving forward with pooling trials will be especially beneficial if the nationwide roll out is
18 postponed. In addition, it will enhance our chances of moving ahead in the nationwide roll
19 out since it will satisfy a key element that the FCC will use to prioritize NPAs.

1 **Q. WHY DO YOU RECOMMEND THAT THE COMMISSION MOVE TO INITIATE STATE TRIALS**
2 **ONLY IF IT IS COMMITTED TO EXPEDITING THE PROCESS AND AGGRESSIVELY RECLAIMING**
3 **CODES?**

4 A. Public Counsel is concerned that unless the process is expedited and Missouri is aggressive
5 in reclaiming codes, we will not gain an advantage in the order of NPAs in the nationwide
6 roll out, we will not substantially extend the life of our existing codes, and consumers will
7 suffer the resulting unnecessary costs.

8 **Q. WHAT TIMEFRAMES HAVE OTHER STATES ACHIEVED IN ESTABLISHING POOLING TRIALS?**

9 A. There was a 6-7 month window from the time the New York Public Service Commission
10 received delegated authority to implement number pooling until the initial date the trials
11 were ordered to begin.⁷ From the time that the California Commission received delegated
12 authority from the FCC until the scheduled initiation of pooling trials took just over 6
13 months.⁸

14 **Q. DOES THIS CONCLUDE YOUR TESTIMONY?**

15 A. Yes.
