Thank you for your August 11, 2021 letter regarding the Spire STL Pipeline LLC (“Spire”) application for a Temporary Emergency Certificate or in the alternative a Limited-Term Certificate in Docket No. CP17-40. I’ve placed your letter and this response in the Commission record.
