JOINT MOTION TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW, the parties to this matter as noted below and, as directed at the May 12, 2009 prehearing conference, move that the Commission establish the following proposed procedural schedule in this matter:

June 8, 2009, 4:00 PM	Factual Affidavits
June 10, 2009, 12:00 PM	Notice of intent to cross-examine or to waive cross-examination of witnesses
June 11-12, 2009	Hearing

In order to further expedite this case, the parties have agreed to shorten the time length for objections to discovery requests to seven days and the time for responses to discovery requests to fifteen days.

The parties believe that there is a strong likelihood that this matter will settle without the need to have a hearing. Whether the matter settles or not, the parties expect to provide the Commission with a stipulation of facts, either to provide factual support for the approval of a Stipulation and Agreement, or as a means to minimize hearing time. Although the parties anticipate that any hearing would be live, with no pre-filed testimony, the parties plan to provide each other with affidavits by their witnesses to give notice of what the witnesses intend to testify and to allow the parties to determine whether they may waive cross-examination and thus allow

the affidavits of any witnesses to be accepted into evidence in lieu of an appearance at the hearing, if there are no questions for them.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned parties request that the Commission order the procedural schedule as set forth above.
