

PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW the undersigned parties to this proceeding, and respectfully state as follows:

1. On May 24, 2000, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE"), a regulated utility, and Intercounty Electric Cooperative Association ("Intercounty"), hereinafter collectively known as "the Applicants," filed a Joint Application requesting that the Commission: 1) approve a Territorial Agreement between the Applicants, based on a finding that it is not detrimental to the public interest; 2) authorize the Applicants to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Territorial Agreement; 3) find that the Territorial Agreement shall not impair AmerenUE's certificates of convenience and necessity, except as specifically limited by the Territorial Agreement; and 4) approve AmerenUE's proposed changes to its tariffs.

2. On May 26, 2000, the Commission issued an Order and Notice, directing that a procedural schedule be filed in this docket by June 22, 2000, with the hearing to be held no later than August 25, 2000; that notice be sent to interested parties; and that any applications to intervene be filed by June 15, 2000.

3. On June 9, 2000, the City of Rolla, Missouri filed an application to intervene in

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this case, and the Commission granted the application on June 20, 2000. To date, no other applications to intervene have been filed.

4. The Applicants, the Commission Staff, the City of Rolla, and the Office of the Public Counsel (collectively, "the Parties"), have reached an agreement in principle in this matter, and are in the process of finalizing a Stipulation and Agreement for presentation to the Commission.

5. Accordingly, the Parties hereby propose the following Procedural Schedule, which will allow compliance with the statutorily mandated 120-day period for action by the Commission.




