## PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) and, on behalf of; the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission; the City of Rolla, Missouri, by and through Rolla Municipal Utilities; and the City of St. James, Missouri, by and through St. James Municipal Utilities, <sup>1</sup> states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

1. The Commission's July 9, 2010, Order Setting Prehearing Conference set this

matter for a prehearing conference on July 20, 2010, and directed that the parties file a

proposed procedural schedule no later than July 23, 2010.

2. A prehearing conference was held as scheduled on July 20, 2010.

3. As a result of the parties' discussions at the prehearing conference, the parties believe that a hearing should be scheduled in this matter. It is proposed that a hearing be scheduled for September 8-9, 2010.

4. It is anticipated that at the hearing the parties would present witnesses (to present live direct testimony, be cross-examined and respond to queries from the

6. The above-referenced parties also agree to the following matter and request that this agreement be reflected in the Commission's order setting the procedural schedule:

The response time for data requests shall be 10 calendar days to provide the requested information, and 5 calendar days to object or notify the requesting party that more than 10 days will be needed to provide the requested information. This expedited schedule shall only apply if the requesting party serves the data requests by email transmitted to the counsel (if any) for that party. Failure to serve the counsel by email will result in the data request being subject to the normal deadlines in the Commission's rules.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE respectfully requests that the Commission consider this pleading to comply with its Order Setting Prehearing Conference and, thereafter, issue such orders as the Commission believes to be reasonable and just.
