## INTERCOUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE'S RESPONSE TO THE CITY OF ROLLA'S APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

Comes now Intercounty Electric Cooperative Association (Intercounty) and in response to the City of Rolla's Application for Rehearing in this matter respectfully submits the following to the Commission:

- 1. In its application for rehearing of the Commission's Report and Order issued on March 15, 2001, the City of Rolla (Rolla) objects to paragraphs in the Report and Order which assign service territory between the Rolla and Intercounty. Rolla argues that the assignments of territory made by the Commission in its Report and Order restate the effect of governing statutes, including §§386.800 and 392.315 RSMo. Since this is the case, Intercounty argues that there is nothing invalid about the Report and Order. Intercounty contends that the matters advanced in Rolla's application for rehearing do not rise to a level which requires modification of the Report and Order. The findings and conclusions of the Report and Order are legally satisfactory and proper as written. Accordingly, Intercounty suggests that the application for rehearing be denied.
- 2. In its review of the Commission's Report and Order, Intercounty did discover a matter which should be clarified. At mid-page of page 18 of the Report and Order, where the Commission was stating its findings of fact, the Commission wrote: "The negotiation period expired on September 3, 1999, and Intercounty filed its application with the Commission on October 29,



1999." The pleadings will confirm that it was the City of Rolla, rather than Intercounty, which filed the application in this case on October 29, 1999.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Intercounty respectfully requests that the Commission deny Rolla's application for rehearing.
