9 10	Q.	Please state your name, position, and address.
11	A.	My name is Debra Buhr. I am a Supervisor in the St. Louis, Missouri Customer
12	Contact Cen	ter at AmerenUE, 1901 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63103. I have held
13	this position	since 1991.
14	Q.	What are your primary job duties?
15	A.	My primary job duties include investigating, responding and resolving, if
16	possible, cor	nsumer complaints and inquiries from various public interests and government
17	agencies inc	luding the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Better Business Bureau and
18	local media.	In this capacity I coordinate with various departments within the Company to
19	gather respo	nsive information.
20	Q.	Have you reviewed the complaint filed by Ms. Ross with the Missouri Public
21	Service Cor	nmission?
22	A.	Yes, I have. Ms. Ross filed a complaint with the MPSC disputing certain charges
23	associated w	vith gas service provided by Union Electric Company during a period in which the
24	gas meter at	her home failed to register usage.
25	Q.	During what period of time did the gas meter at Ms. Ross's home fail to
26	properly me	easure gas usage?

7	A.	Appended to my testimony is Schedule A which summarizes the gas usage and
2	charges for N	As Ross's residence during the period January 2001 through January 2002. As set
3	forth in that s	schedule, the gas meter readings on bills dated July 31, August 29, September 30,
4	October 29 a	nd November 28, 2001 all registered the same number – 9573. The fact that the
5	reading num	ber did not change reflects that the gas meter registered zero usage for that period.
6	Q.	Does the Company believe that, notwithstanding the meter reading, Ms. Ross
7	used natura	I gas at her home during this period?
8	A.	Yes.
9	Q.	What is the basis for the Company's belief?
10	Α.	Ms. Ross states that she was at her residence during this time. Furthermore, she
11	timely paid h	her electric and gas bills.
12	Q.	When did the Company first discover that the meter failed to measure gas
13	usage?	
14	A.	The Company runs a report in November of each year to identify all zero usage
15	accounts. Th	nese accounts are then further examined to determine if the zero usage reflects an
16	accurate read	ling or whether equipment or some other failure has occurred. November is used
17	because typic	cally it is the first reliable month in which a gas furnace would be used.
18	Q.	Why didn't the Company discover the meter malfunction earlier?
19	A.	Zero usage does not always equate to an equipment malfunction. The Company
20	has no way o	of knowing the specific appliances a gas customer may have in their home. For
21	example, if a	customer has an electric stove, washer and dryer, or water heater, then a zero usage
22	reading durir	ng the summer may not be indicative of a faulty reading. On the other hand, if the
23	same custom	er has a gas furnace that only consumes gas during the winter, a monthly bill that

1	records zero	usage during a cold weather month is indicative of some sort of system (billing or
2	equipment) p	problem. The report is run in November so as to focus on those accounts where
3	there is a stro	onger likelihood of some sort of external problem.
4	Q.	When was the gas meter either replaced or repaired?
5	A.	The meter was replaced on December 8, 2001 and the replacement meter has
6	functioned p	roperly since that time.
7	Q.	During the period in which the meter failed to register, did the Company bill
8	Ms. Ross for	r gas service?
9	A.	Ms. Ross received a bill that reflected the fixed, monthly customer charge
10	(including ta	x) of \$9.63. She was not billed for gas consumed during this period.
11	Q.	After the Company replaced the meter, did it issue a revised bill to Ms. Ross
12	for gas servi	ice?
13	A.	Yes it did. On January 10, the Company issued a bill totaling \$218.91 which
14	included a re	vised, "catch-up" bill of \$89.25.
15	Q.	Is the \$89.25 the amount in dispute that is before the Commission in this
16	case?	
17	A.	Yes. The specific methodology used by the Company in this case is fairly new.
18	Regrettably,	the Company issued several bills to Ms. Ross that contained differing amounts as to
19	estimated ch	arges. As the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff noted in their investigative
20	report, the co	orrect estimate should be \$113.03. Nevertheless, the Company is standing by its
21	original bill	of \$89.25, as it is more advantageous to Ms. Ross.
22	Q.	How did the Company calculate gas service charges for the July through
23	November 2	001 period in which the gas meter was not registering properly?

1	A.	Since the actual gas usage amount was unknown, the Company prepared a bill
2	based upon a	n estimate of likely usage.
3	Q.	How was this estimate calculated?
4	A.	The estimate of unmetered service was calculated based on Ms. Ross's gas usage
5	during the ap	oplicable comparison period in 2000, along with the number of heating degree days
6	for the corres	sponding period in 2001. (The calculation assumes that base, non-seasonal usage
7	will remain r	elatively constant from one period to the next.) Since temperatures can vary from
8	one year to tl	ne next, heating degree days are used to convert the prior year's monthly usage into
9	the estimated	l usage. Since this estimate assumes gas usage patterns remain constant, the
10	Company is	willing to make adjustments if the customer believes that their actual usage level is
11	less than the	comparison period. Ms. Ross, however, contends she should not be responsible for
12	any portion of	of the unmetered service.
13	Q.	Is the methodology for estimating bills incorporated within the Company's
14	tariffs?	
15	A.	Yes. Tariff Nos. 56, 57 and 57.1 describe the methodology used in calculating
16	her "catch-up	o" bill.
17	Q.	How does the \$89.25 estimated, nonmetered service compare to the actual
18	metered cha	rges on Ms. Ross's account for the same period during calendar year 2000?
19	A.	For the July through November 2000 time period, Ms. Ross's actual metered
20	service was \$	S151.88.
21	Q.	Has the Company charged Ms. Ross late fees associated with the disputed
22	amount?	
23	A.	No.

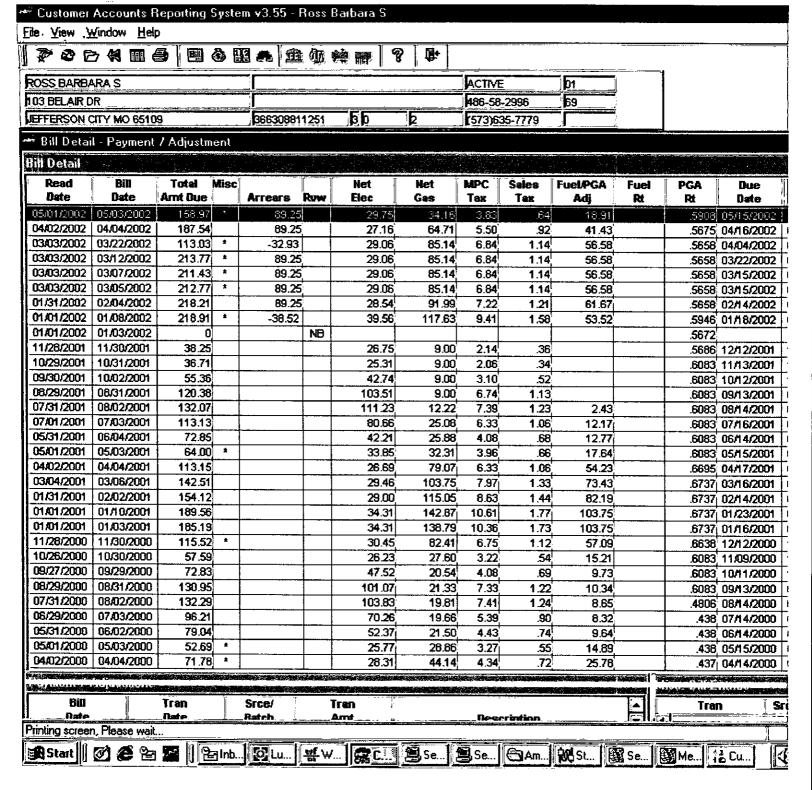

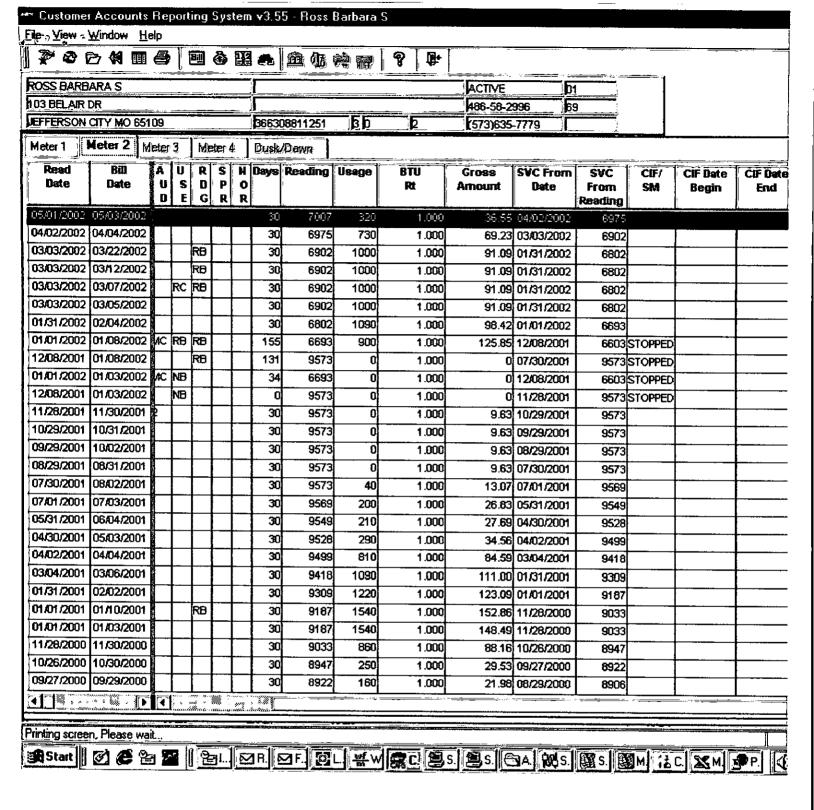
