RENEW MISSOURI'S SUGGESTED SPECIAL CONTEMPORARY ISSUES

COMES NOW, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"), and pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-22.080(4), recommends the following special contemporary issues for consideration and analysis:

1. Analyze and document the current Effective Load Carrying Capacity ratings when evaluating forecasts for utility-scale solar facilities.

2. Analyze and document planning scenarios that include robust storage uptake consistent with FERC Order 841 including identifying current Battery Energy Storage System cost assumptions used to develop the scenario.

3. Analyze and document the reliability benefits associated with additional transmission investments identified.

4. Analyze and document the projected interconnection costs when evaluating additional supply side options.

Analyze and document the impact on Ameren Missouri's resource planning if
MISO moves towards implementing a seasonal capacity auction.

WHEREFORE, Renew Missouri submits these special contemporary issues for the Commission's consideration.
