STAFF'S RESPONSE TO THE VERIFIED MOTION OF UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR WAIVER OF FILING THE CALENDAR YEAR 1986 COST OF SERVICE DATA

Comes now the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) and in response to Union Electric Company's (Company) request for a waiver of the requirement that it file 1986 calendar year data for its electric business states as follows:

1. On November 3, 1986, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order requiring utilities to file a jurisdictional cost of service study based on 1986 data, adjusted to reflect the Tax Reform Act of 1986. This information is due on March 2, 1987.

2. On February 6, 1987, Company filed a motion stating that the filing of this information for its electric business should be waived. In support of its motion, Company stated that Staff auditors are currently compiling a cost-of-service study for Company's electric operations. Company stated that if it filed the 1986 cost-of-service study on March 2, 1987, it would simply duplicate the work presently being performed by Staff. Company also stated that it is not necessary that the data be filed in light of the fact that it has volunteered to reflect the effect of the Tax Reform Act of 1986 in its electric rates.

3. Staff has no objection to Company being granted its requested waiver.
