- 1. On November 17, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement along with a proposed restatement of the issues. The Office of the Public Counsel, The Empire District Electric Company, the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission and SPP were not parties to the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
- 2. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2)(B) provides that the non-signatory parties "shall have seven (7) days from the filing of a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement to file an objection." The rule further provides that "[f]ailure to file a timely objection shall constitute a full waiver of that party's right to a hearing."
- 3. SPP has no objection to the terms of the stipulations included in the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
- 4. SPP reserves its right to fully participate and represent its interests in the hearing to the extent that other matters or issues not addressed or included in the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement are considered by the Commission.
- 5. SPP appreciates the opportunity to be a party to this docket and offers to provide any information that can help the Commission with its deliberations.

WHEREFORE, SPP respectfully requests that the Commission accept this response to the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed in the above referenced case.
