My reasoning for this decision is as follows:

- 2. Technology is changing rapidly, and the devices currently available under the TAP program are, in many cases, outdated and need to be upgraded.
- 3. Elderly people make up the majority of persons with hearing loss in Missouri, and this population is growing rapidly with the aging of the "Baby Boomer" generation. We cannot predict what impact this will have on future telecommunications services and equipment.
- 4. There seems to be a need for greater utilization review of the existing services and equipment. The discussion on October 22 seemed to indicate that there is a fair number of previously installed devices not being used.

It is my hope that, as a committee and in collaboration with the TAP personnel, we can work to become more proactive rather than reactive in this much-needed service.
