1. 2. Ameren Missouri has met with MPSC Staff, Office of the Public Counsel and Division of Energy.
3. The Company is currently engaged in discussions and evaluating possible alternatives.
4. Ameren Missouri requests leave to file a status report by no later than Tuesday, September 22, 2015.
