AFFIDAVIT OF SHERRY P. MOSCHNER

Comes now affiant, Sherry P. Moschner, who, being first duly sworn and upon her oath, states and deposes as follows:

- I am employed as a Manager, Customer Relations, by respondent Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. I am over eighteen years of age and have personal knowledge of the facts set out herein.
- I have read the November 29, 2001 Staff Report prepared by Jim Ketter and find it to be a thorough and fair compilation of the facts pertaining to the Complaint filed in this matter. While I concur with the findings and conclusions set out in the Staff Report, I believe that some points of clarification are necessary.
- Reference is made interchangeably throughout the Staff Report to Sterling Moody and Sterlings Marketplace. The same is true in the chronology set forth in Attachment A to the Report. I believe it should be made clear that

Sterling Moody was never a customer on any of the accounts or meters referenced in the Staff Report or in the Complaint which was filed in this matter. At all times pertinent to the issues set out in the Complaint, these accounts have been billed as corporate accounts.

- 4. I would also like to clarify some facts pertaining to the disconnection of electric service to Meter No. 70593313 at 8350 North Broadway that occurred on April 10, 2001. That disconnection of service, which is referenced on page one of the Staff Report and in Attachment A, lasted only approximately three hours before service was restored. Attachment A does state that service was reconnected the same day but does not state the duration of the interruption in service.
- More importantly, I would emphasize that the issue with respect to this disconnection of service, as found by Mr. Ketter, relates to the inadvertent disconnection which occurred without the notice required by the Commission's rules. The Staff Report does not conclude the disconnection itself was unjustified. In fact, it was the failure of Sterlings Marketplace I, Inc. to pay its bills in a timely manner that led to the disconnection of service.
- 6. While it is not clear from the Staff Report, the disconnection of service that occurred on April 17, 2001 to Meter 70593313 was done pursuant to proper and timely notice. Service remained disconnected until after the May 18, 2001 agreement (Attachment D to the Staff Report) was signed in which the customer, Sterlings Marketplace I, Inc., and the landlord for the

property, P. & B. Real Estate, L.L.C., accepted responsibility for payment for service to the three meters. As Mr. Ketter notes in his Report, respondent AmerenUE, as a result of the May 18, 2001 agreement, wrote off over \$135,000 that was due on these two accounts. In addition, neither Sterlings Marketplace I, Inc. nor P. & B. Real Estate, L.L.C. have complied with the terms of the agreement since that date. As noted in the Notice of Discontinuance of Service filed by respondent AmerenUE on November 27, 2001, an additional \$45,038.94 is due and owing for electric service to these two accounts from May 18, 2001 to September 26, 2001. This does not include an additional \$11,714.87 for service to these accounts through November 21, 2001, when service was discontinued. This amount does not include any late fees that are due.
