## **ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE**

Issue Date: May 25, 2005

Effective Date: June 4, 2005

On May 13, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority of Missouri Payphone, Inc., a company that has been authorized to provide private payphone service by the Commission. Staff's motion states that it has received a FY-2005 Statement of Revenue from the company indicating that Missouri Payphone has been out of business since 2000. Staff also indicates that according to the Missouri Secretary of State's website, the company was administratively dissolved on September 4, 2002. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide private payphone services that has been issued to the company. Missouri Payphone has not responded to Staff's motion.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2004), which states, in part: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the statement of the company included in that motion, and on the failure of the company to respond, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Missouri Payphone should be canceled.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the certificate of authority to provide private payphone services granted to Missouri Payphone, Inc., in Case Number TA-96-233, is canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on June 4, 2005.
3. That this case may be closed on June 5, 2005.
