ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION, SETTING TEST YEAR,
AND SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 16, 1993, the Commission issued its Order Establishing Docket, Setting Intervention Date And Setting Procedural Schedule Date for the purpose of conducting Phase II of St. Joseph Light & Power Company's (SJLP) class cost of service study. Thereafter, by order dated August 3, 1993, the Commission set a technical conference and ordered the parties to submit a memorandum setting out those issues agreed to be considered in Phase II, the proper test year to be used, along with a procedural schedule by November 4, 1993. On November 4, 1993, the parties filed the requested memorandum complying with the Commission's previous order.

Based upon the joint recommendation of the parties, the Commission will approve the suggested test year and the suggested tentative procedural schedule. Also, the Commission will grant intervention to AG Processing, Inc. (AGP), which entered the docket through its Application To Intervene filed herein on July 2, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That intervention in this case be hereby granted to AG Processing, Inc.
2. That the proposed test year of the twelve-month period ending September 30, 1993, be hereby approved for Phase II of St. Joseph Light & Power Company's cost of service study.

3. That the following procedural schedule be hereby adopted:

- March 2, 1994 - SJLP provides all parties with:
(1) hourly loads by cost of service classes and losses; (2) billing units by tariff and cost of service classes, and
(3) individual customer data tapes.
- June 1, 1994 - Staff provides all parties with:
(1) weather-normalized hourly load data for cost of service classes, and
(2) weather-normalized kwh data by cost of service and tariff classes.
- July 1, 1994 - SJLP and/or Staff provide all parties with: (1) weather-normalized billing units and revenues by cost of service and tariff classes, (2) normalized fuel expense data, (3) distribution cost studies, (4) load characteristics, cost of service class coincident peak, non-coincident peak and customer maximum demand data, and (5) accounting cost data.
- Sept. 1, 1994 - Parties complete and distribute class cost of service studies.
- Nov. 1, 1994 - Parties complete and distribute their rate design studies.
- Dec. 2, 1994 - Parties file direct testimony.
- Jan. 9-13, 1995 - 10:00 a.m. (first day) - Parties participate in prehearing conference, file hearing memorandum.
- Jan. 27, 1995 - Parties file rebuttal testimony.
- Feb. 10, 1995 - Parties file surrebuttal testimony.
- Feb. 20-24, 1995 - 10:00 a.m. (first day) - Evidentiary hearings.
- (30 days after filing of transcript - parties file initial briefs.)

The prehearing conference and hearing will be held in the Commission's hearing room on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.

3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
