ORDER DENYING MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 19, 1992, the Commission established a procedural schedule in this matter, a case initiated by Staff's audit of Company's revenues and natural gas costs for the ACA period September, 1990 to August, 1991.

On June 25, 1992, Company and Staff jointly filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule, generally stating that neither Company nor Staff have had enough time to "meet informally" or to otherwise resolve their differences "without resort to more formal litigation techniques."

Company and Staff propose to meet informally and, in the interim, ask the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule it ordered on June 19, 1992, and, in lieu thereof, state they will jointly propose another procedural schedule after their meeting(s).

Having considered the joint motion, the Commission is of the opinion that the parties may, and perhaps should, meet informally. That option has been available to Staff and Company since May 1, 1992. The Commission will therefore amend the procedural schedule as follows in order to facilitate said meeting(s) between Company and Staff, however informal.
