ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF CHANGE OF NAME

This order requires Claricom Networks, Inc. to file a change of name.

On November 15, 2001, the joint application to transfer stock filed on June 7, 2001, by Claricom Networks, Inc.; Claricom Holdings, Inc.; Staples, Inc.; Stacom Holdings, LLC; and Platinum Equity, LLC, was approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission. Paragraph 5 of the application stated, in part: "Pursuant to the [Purchase and Sale] Agreement, [Claricom Networks, Inc.] will be converted to a limited liability company and all of the outstanding stock in Claricom will be transferred from Seller to Buyer."

In the order approving the transaction, the Commission required its Staff to file no later than November 26, 2001, a report stating whether Claricom Networks, Inc.'s proposed conversion to a limited liability company would trigger any required action by the Commission and, if so, what that action would be.

On November 26, 2001, the Staff filed its report, recommending that the Commission order Claricom to file an application for a change of name under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(16). That rule sets forth the three items required by the Commission to accomplish the recognition of a change of name. The rule states:

A name change may be accomplished by filing the items below with a cover letter requesting a change of name. Notwithstanding any other provision of these rules, the items required herein may be filed by a nonattorney. Applications for approval of a change of name shall include: (A) A statement, clearly setting out both the old name and the new name; (B) Evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri secretary of state; and (C) Either an adoption notice and revised tariff title sheet with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application, or revised tariff sheets with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application.

On December 10, 2001, the parties filed a notification of a stock transfer, indicating that the parties completed the stock transfer in August. The Commission will thus order Claricom to file a change of name.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Claricom Networks, Inc. must file no later than March 1, 2002, a pleading complying with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(16).
 - 2. That this order will become effective on December 23, 2001.


