ORDER

On October 24, 1986, Republic Telcom Corporation (Republic Telcom) filed its Motion for Extension of Time in which to File Tariffs in Case No. TO-84-222, et al. On October 28, 1986, Republic Telcom filed its Motion for Extension of Time in which to File PIU Report in Case No. TO-84-222, et al. Republic Telcom stated that it is presently undergoing a corporate reorganization process which has prevented it from having adequate time to prepare and submit its tariffs and PIU Report by October 25, 1986. Republic Telcom requests an extension of time until October 31, 1986, to file its reseller tariff and PIU Report.

On October 27, 1986, Allnet Communication Services, Inc. (Allnet) filed its letter requesting an additional thirty (30) days to file its waivers from the appropriate Commission rules and regulations in Case No. TO-84-222, et al. Allnet

stated because of the volume of rules involved, it needs more time to prepare its request for waivers.

Having considered the requests of Republic Telcom and Allnet, the Commission finds that they are reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Republic Telcom Corporation's Motion for Extension of Time in which to File Tariffs and its Motion for Extension of Time in which to File PIU Report be, and hereby are, granted.

ORDERED: 2. That Allnet Communication Services, Inc.'s request for an extension until November 28, 1986, to file its request for a variance from any Commission rule, be and hereby is, granted.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
