ORDER

On August 6, 1985, the Commission issued its Order Extending the InterLATA Access Charge and IntraLATA Toll Pools through March 31, 1986, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Since that date, hearings have been held, transcripts have been filed and a briefing schedule has been established in the above-styled cases. Initial briefs are to be filed on March 24, 1986 and reply briefs are to be filed on April 8, 1986. To allow time for the Commission to make its decision in these matters after receipt of the briefs, it is necessary to extend the InterLATA Access Charge and IntraLATA Toll Pools from March 31, 1986 to July 10, 1986.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the InterLATA Access Charge and IntraLATA Toll Pools be, and are, hereby extended through July 10, 1986, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
