ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

By its Order issued in this case on May 13, 1987, this Commission ordered the establishment of one-way Extended Area Service (EAS) from the Tebbetts exchange of Kingdom Telephone Company to the Jefferson City exchange of United Telephone Company of Missouri on or before July 14, 1987.

On June 12, 1987, Kingdom Telephone Company submitted for Commission approval revised tariff sheets designed to establish one-way EAS from its Tebbetts exchange to the Jefferson City exchange. The monthly rates reflected on the proposed tariff are \$8.45 for residence subscribers and \$12.65 for business subscribers in conformance with the Order of the Commission.

On June 24, 1987, Kingdom Telephone Company submitted a substitute tariff sheet designed to clarify the voting procedure and definition of EAS.

The Commission is of the opinion the proposed tariff sheets submitted June 12, 1987, and subsequently revised by filing submitted June 24, 1987, complies with its Order issued May 13, 1987, and said tariff sheets should be allowed to become effective on July 14, 1987.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the following tariff sheets submitted on June 12, 1987, and the substitute tariff sheet submitted on June 24, 1987, by Kingdom Telephone Company, designed to establish one-way EAS from its Tebbetts exchange to the Jefferson City exchange of United Telephone Company of Missouri be, and the same are, hereby approved for service rendered on and after July 14, 1987.

Purpose of Filing:

Establish One-Way EAS to Jefferson City, Case No. TO-85-191

The attached proposed tariff sheet is designed to establish one-way Extended Area Service (EAS) from the Tebbetts exchange of Kingdom Telephone Company to the Jefferson City exchange in conformance to the Order issued by the Commission in Case No. TO-85-191 on May 13, 1987, (copy attached).

The revised tariff indicates a monthly charge for the EAS service of \$8.45 for residence subscribers and \$12.65 for business subscribers.

On June 24, 1987, the company submitted a substitute tariff designed to clarify the voting procedure to establish and discontinue EAS, revise percentage of customers voting and clarify the definition of EAS.

The proposed tariff establishes a Discontinuance of EAS (vote-out procedure) to make provision for subscribers to petition for the elimination of the service. As in such rules for other telephone companies, Kingdom proposes that at least two years shall have elapsed since the last survey before such a survey will be conducted.

It is the opinion of the Staff of the Communications Department that the proposed tariff complies with the Order of the Commission and should be approved.

Attached for your consideration is a draft of an Order Approving Tariff Sheets in Case No. TO-85-191.
