ORDER DENYING MOTION

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On December 29, 1986, certain of the mining intervenors in Case No. ER-85-265 filed their Motion To Reduce Tariffs Of Arkansas Power & Light Company Effective January 1, 1987, To Reflect Decreased Federal Income Tax Rates.

The motion raises new contested issues beyond the scope of the record in Case No. ER-85-265. The record of that case has been closed, an order has been issued and become effective, and the case has been appealed to the Missouri Court of Appeals, Western District.

In the Commission's opinion, it is improper to attempt to alter or supplement the record in Case No. ER-85-265 under those conditions. Accordingly, the motion is improperly filed. The matters raised by the intervenors' motion of December 29, 1986, will be considered in Case No. AC-87-48.

For the foregoing reasons, the intervenors' motion of December 29, 1986, should be denied.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Motion To Reduce Tariffs Of Arkansas Power & Light Company Effective January 1, 1987, To Reflect Decreased Federal Income Tax Rates filed on December 29, 1986, by ASARCO, Inc., and Doe Run Company, a general partner and successor to St. Joe Minerals Corporation and AMAX Lead Company of Missouri, Inc., be, and is, hereby denied.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
