ORDER APPROVING ACTUAL COST ADJUSTMENT AND CLOSING CASE

On April 1, 1991, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending several adjustments to United Cities Gas Company's (United Cities) 1989-1990 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing for its Hannibal-Canton District. All adjustments proposed by Staff were agreed upon by United Cities with the exception of the disallowance of \$20,430.91 of take-or-pay costs. Staff recommended that United Cities' filing remain "interim subject to refund" until the outstanding issue was resolved.

On March 13, 1992, the Commission issued a Report and Order within Case No. GR-92-21 which states that United Cities is entitled to retain the \$20,430.91 in take-or-pay costs. On April 13, 1992, Staff filed a memorandum recommending that, with the last outstanding issue resolved, the Commission should approve United Cities' 1989-1990 ACA filing; change the rates effective from that filing from "interim subject to refund" status to "permanent" status; and close the docket.

Based upon Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that United Cities' 1989-1990 ACA rates should be approved on a permanent basis. The Commission also determines that, since all issues in this docket have been resolved, this case should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Actual Cost Adjustment rates filed in this case by United Cities Gas Company for the period 1989-1990 are hereby approved on a permanent basis.
 - 2. That Case No. GR-90-39 is hereby closed.
 - 3. That this Order shall become effective on April 28, 1992.
