## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of service authority granted to Micro-Tel, Inc.

On April 21, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority, requesting that the Commission cancel Micro-Tel, Inc.'s certificate of service authority to provide payphone service. The Commission granted that certificate to Micro-Tel in Case No. TA-94-215.

In support of its motion, Staff states that Micro-Tel has indicated to Staff that the company is out of business. In addition, the Missouri Secretary of State's website indicates that the company was dissolved on August 28, 2000, for failure to file an annual registration report. Staff indicates that the company does not owe any assessments or annual reports.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that parties have ten days to respond to motions. Micro-Tel failed to timely respond. Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that it should cancel Micro-Tel's private pay telephone service certificate of service authority.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority is granted.
- 2. That the private pay telephone service certificate of service authority granted to Micro-Tel, Inc., in Case No. TA-94-215 is canceled.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on May 13, 2005.
  - 4. That this case may be closed on May 14, 2005.
