On April 15, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority of Pay Phone Concepts, Inc. ("PPC"), a company that has been authorized to offer private pay telephone services by the Commission.

In Case Number TA-95-266, the Commission granted PPC a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned telephone equipment.

Staff's motion states that PPC requested the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority because the company was sold September 30, 2007 and is no longer providing service in Missouri. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion and PPC's request to cancel its certificate, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Pay Phone Concepts, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide private pay telephone services

granted to Pay Phone Concepts, Inc., in Case Number TA-95-266 is canceled.

- 2. This order shall become effective on May 12, 2008.
- 3. This case may be closed on May 13, 2008.
