ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAY
TELEPHONE CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: April 1, 2009

Effective Date: April 11, 2009

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of Jay Noel d/b/a Allied Phone Service ("APS").

On March 12, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting APS' certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled.

In Case Number TA-97-32, the Commission granted APS a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.

Staff's motion states that APS requested its certificate be canceled because they are no longer providing service in Missouri. No formal complaints have been filed against this payphone provider since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System. In addition, Staff states APS owes no annual assessments to the Commission.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion and because APS is no longer providing telecommunications service in Missouri, the Commission finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Jay Noel d/b/a Allied Phone Service shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The private payphone certificate granted to Jay Noel d/b/a Allied Phone Service, in Case Number TA-97-32, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on April 11, 2009.
3. This case may be closed on April 12, 2009.
